Championship Information

Format & Prizes:

Championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low 60 scores and ties for the final round. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the championship. Top 30 scores will receive merchandise and are exempt into the 2019 North Carolina Mid-Amateur Championship. Merchandise certificates are valid until September 9, 2019.
