Championship Information

Format and Prizes:

Championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low 60 scores and ties for the final round. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the championship. Top 30 scores will receive merchandise and are exempt into the 2019 North Carolina Senior Championship. Merchandise certificates are valid until December 31, 2018. Champion receives a trophy, merchandise from host club and possession of the Peter V. Tufts Trophy for the ensuing year.
