Practice Round Information:

Available: Sunday, April 28 and in advance by availability.
Call (336) 299-0427 after April 1, 2019 to schedule a practice round.
Practice round fee: \$35, regardless of cart rental. Players may rent a golf cart for the practice round.

Caddies/Transportation:

Participants must walk at all times during the qualifying rounds, with the exception of any Committee-provided shuttles.
Caddies are allowed to transport clubs in motorized carts during the qualifying rounds for a fee of \$25 for the day.
Push/Pull carts are permitted.

Range:

Range balls will be available at no cost. The range will be open at 6:30 a.m. on the day of competition.

Starting Times:

First round starting times will begin at 7:30 a.m. on holes #1 and #11. Starting Times will be emailed to competitors by April 23, 2019.
