Code of Conduct for Spectators

On the course during stipulated rounds, spectators may:



- Walk or drive carts on cart paths, or in the rough (please be aware of ALL groups on the course)
- Stand near the green (but out of the way) while players are putting
- Tell players “good shot”, etc.
- Carry food, drinks, umbrellas, etc. to be given to players as needed
- Help look for lost balls
- Report the facts of a situation to the rules committee, **if asked**

Spectators may NOT:



- Walk with or drive carts along with the players
- Be on the greens or fringes
- Give players advice
- Carry clubs or other equipment for players
- Give a ruling for any reason
- Use cell phones on the course, except for emergencies or to contact golf shop to ask for assistance

Remember: Avoid the “appearance of evil”. Avoid conversations or any kind of signal that could be construed as giving advice.

General Reminders

While at the host club, please observe the club's rules for cell phone use on the grounds. Be sure to adhere to any dress code at the host club.

Please express your appreciation to the host club for their hospitality. Remember that these tournaments would not be possible without clubs that are willing to give up their facilities for the girls.
