


2. Once you click on the link, it will direct you to this portal. From here you will select the settings icon then select dashboard.






3. Select the dropdown under "season" to make sure you are in either all seasons or 2021.

Welcome to your Team Matches Dashboard. As a team captain, you have access to the following pages in the Manager Site:

- . Course Details: Manage the courses used your matches and add new courses.
- Edit Match Pairings: Add, remove, and move players in the pairings for your matches.
- Edit Course & Tee Assignments: Set the course & tee, tee times, and shotgun starts.
- Enter Hole-by-Hole Scores: If permitted, enter hole by hole scores for your matches.
- Post Scores to GHIN: Post scores from finalized rounds to GHIN.
- Display Leaderboard: View and print the Manager Site leaderboard.
- Print Scorecards: Print scorecards using the available templates. You do not have permission to create and customize scorecards.
- Round Profile: Access the Round Profile to change the round date (if necessary).
- Report Center: Print reports (e.g., alpha list, tee sheet, cart signs, etc) available in the Report Center. You do not have permission to create and customize reports.
- Handicap Analysis: View the detailed computation of Course Handicaps for your matches.
- Run the Pre-Play Audit: Check your round setup by running the Pre-Play audit.



Set the Team Roster and Pairings


1. In the team captain menu, you will first select the match you would like to create pairings for in the dropdown on the left and then select "Edit Match Play Pairings"

*Note: Always make sure you are in the correct round before you start editing your pairings!






2. Select your Team.






2. Select "Add New Player" to add someone from your club to your roster.

*Note: These players will stay on your roster for the remainder of the season. There is no need to do this before every match.





- 4. A new box will appear and you will do the following:
 - 1. Type in your players name and select "search"
 - 2. Select "Add"
 - 3. Select "Done"






5. Make sure you order by handicap index and not course index.


- 6. Select an empty box and then select the dropdown arrow by "Choose a player." Sort players by handicap index to help you enter your team in handicap order.
- *Note: If you do not see some of the players you added, just select "save team changes" and refresh the page.






7. Select the player from your roster that you would like to play in your match and then select "Go."


Note*: After each player you add, you will need to select an empty box and select the "choose a player" dropdown again to add another player. Work in left to right order as oppose to up and down.








8. If you need to remove a player, just select the player's box and then select "Remove."





9. Make sure you select "Save Team Changes" or else your pairings will not be saved!!!







Setting Up the Match


1. If you need to edit the date of the match, go to "Round Profile" in the Team Captain Menu.








2. Click on the box and select a new playing date.






3. Once you have a playing date, In the Team Captain Menu, select "Edit Course & Tee Assignments"

*Note: Always make sure you are in the correct round before you start editing!






- 4. To choose which course and tees are being played,

 - 3. Choose your course and tee in the dropdown menu and select "Go"





- 5. To set tee times for the players:
 - 1. Select "Set Tee Time"
 - 2. Select All
 - 3. Enter the time of the first tee time
 - 4. Enter the interval between each tee time
 - 5. Select "Go"



6. Make sure you select "Save Pairings" or else your match will not be set up correctly!!






Adjusting a Playing Handicap


If a player in the match is on the "penalty list," here is how you adjust their playing handicap.

1. Select "Handicap Analysis" in the Team Captain Menu.





2. Select the name of the player being adjusted.








Printing Scorecards

*Note: Do **NOT** select Print Scorecards








2. Select the Interclub folder


*Note: If you click the star next to where it says "Interclub" it will automatically move it to the top of the list for you.




Entering Scores

1. In the Team Captain Menu, select "Enter Hole-by-Hole Scores"






2. Select the individual match that you would like to enter scores for






3. Enter each individuals **GROSS SCORE** for each hole. If a player did not finish a hole, enter their score most likely taken or net double bogey. After all scores are entered, select "Done"






4. After each match is green and says "All Holes Completed," select "Done Entering Scores"






5. If you would like to view the leaderboard from the match, select "Display Leaderboard" in the Team Captain Menu.






6. Select "Fourball Matches 18 Holes"








8. Lastly, you will need to post scores to GHIN. First, select "Post Scores to GHIN" in the Team Captain Menu.






- 9. Select the Score Type dropdown and select "Competition." Then select "Post Scores" and each players adjusted gross scores will be posted to GHIN.
- *Note: If you want to only post scores from your team, unselect all players from the other team.






10. Once scores have been entered and posted, change the round status to "Completed"






Live Scoring

1. If you wish to enable live scoring for your match, click on the slider next to "Enable Mobile Score Entry" in the Team Captain Menu.





2. Click "Save" when this pop-up appears





3. To Enter Live Scores, you must use the Golf Genius app. When you open the app, enter the GGID located at the bottom of your scorecard.


5. If you would like to view the scores from other matches, just click on "Leaderboard" at the top.






Viewing the Standings
