

**53rd Junior Championship
of the Carolinas Golf Association

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 18th birthday by the last day of the championship, is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, and whose parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules will be distributed at the starter's table. The Carolinas Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Each competitor must walk and carry his/her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be **17 or younger** and must walk. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited.

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play for the 12-13, 14-15, and 16-17 divisions and 27 holes of stroke play for the 11 and under division. The 12-13 and 11 and under divisions will play a shortened course. The champion is the low scorer in the two upper age groups. After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the low half and ties in each age division. All 11 and under players will qualify for the final round.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the winners, second-place and third-place finishers in each division. The low four scorers in the 14-17 division qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Team Matches, August 10-11 at Pine Needles Lodge and Golf Club and Mid Pines Golf Club in Southern Pines, NC. *The M.K. Jeffords Trophy* will be held by the winner of the boys 14-17 division for the ensuing year.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. No entry will be accepted prior to the opening date. Entries will be accepted until 5 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information will be sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked weekly at www.thecga.org.

Entries must be returned to the Carolinas Golf Association, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of a verified player illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made for any reason on or after July 26.

Pairings and starting times will be posted at the club and at www.thecga.org the day before the championship. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

Detach, sign and mail the entry form with your fee to Carolinas Golf Association, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Entries received before the opening date will be returned. Entry fee is \$20. Incomplete or illegible forms will be returned. **Keep the bottom portion for your records.**

EXEMPTIONS AND QUALIFYING

11 and under: First 24 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date.

12-13: First 24 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date.

14-17: Any players making the cut at the 2001 CGA Junior (see reverse) regardless of age division and those players ranked lowest by the TYGA NC and SCJGA SC Junior rankings as of July 10, 2002 who filed applications with the CGA office by July 17 up to a total of 107.

Qualifying: In the 14-17 division only, those not included in the above categories will have the opportunity to enter a qualifier July 29, 2002 at Crossings Golf Club in Florence, South Carolina. A minimum of seven spots will be available.

Championship Schedule

Monday, July 29

Course open for practice. Qualifying for non-exempt players at Crossings Golf Club in Florence, SC.

Tuesday, July 30

First round: 18 holes of stroke play for older divisions and nine holes for 11 and under age divisions.

Wednesday, July 31

Second round: Same format as Tuesday. Older divisions cut.

Thursday, August 1

Final round. (All age divisions)
