ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any amateur golfer who has not reached his or her 18th birthday by the last day of the championship, is a legal resident of North Carolina, and whose parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules will be distributed at the starter's table. The Carolinas Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Each competitor must walk and carry his/her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be **17 or younger** and must walk. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited.

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at match play. There will be an 18-hole stroke-play qualifying round to determine match play qualifiers and seedings.

PRIZES AND TEAM MATCHES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists, quarterfinalists and medalist in the boys 14-17 age division; to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists and medalist in the boys 13 and under age division; and to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists, quarterfinalists and medalist in the girls' division. The champion and runner-up of the boys' 14-17 age division qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Boys Team Matches, August 10-11, 2002 at Pine Needles Lodge and Golf Club and Mid Pines Golf Club in Southern Pines, NC. The girls semi-finalists qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginia/Maryland Girls Team Matches, August 10-11, 2002 at Independence Golf Club in Richmond, VA. *The Harry L. Welch Trophy* will be held by the winner for the ensuing year by the boys 14-17 champion. *The Linda Marsh Trophy* will be held by the winner for the ensuing year by the girls

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. No entry will be accepted prior to the opening date. Entries will be accepted until 5 p.m. of the closing date. <u>The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier</u>. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information will be sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked weekly at www.thecga.org.

Entries must be returned to the Carolinas Golf Association, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. <u>Only one entry per check.</u> Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of a verified player illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made for any reason on or after June 14.

Pairings and starting times will be posted at the club and at www.thecga.org the day before the championship. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

EXEMPTIONS AND QUALIFYING

Girls: First 32 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date.

Boys 13 and under: First 28 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date.

Boys 14-17: Any players making match play at the 2001 NC Junior (see reverse) regardless of age division and those players ranked lowest by the TYGA NC Junior rankings as of June 5, 2002 who filed applications with the CGA office by June 5 up to a total of 91.

Qualifying: In the Boys 14-17 division only, those not included in the above categories will have the opportunity to enter a qualifier June 17, 2002 at Flag Tree of Fairmont Golf Club in Fairmont, NC. A minimum of five spots will be available.
