ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any team comprised of a parent and child in any combination **excluding male-male**. Step-parents and grandparents are allowed. In-laws are <u>NOT</u> eligible. At least one member of each team must be a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, be a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association, have a current (within 90 days of opening date) CGA handicap index or is a golf professional employed at a CGA member club. A team is eligible if one partner is an amateur member of a CGA member club or if one partner is a golf professional employed by a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. The minimum age for entry is eight years as of the tournament date.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules will be distributed at the starter's table. The Carolinas Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like is <u>NOT</u> allowed. **Any team failing to show for its assigned starting time without reasonable notification will be refused entry into future CGA Parent-Child championships.**

FORMAT

Each team will play alternate shot except that both team members hit from each tee and then select the ball to be played. A team must then complete the hole with the ball selected. Teams will be pre-flighted into divisions according to team handicap index. Team handicap index is computed by adding 2/3 of the lower handicap index to 1/3 of the higher handicap index. Golf professionals are scratch handicap for net team prizes.

PRIZES

Merchandise and trophies will be awarded to the overall champion. Merchandise will be distributed in each division to low-net winners based upon the number of entries.

ENTRIES

Each team must complete an official entry form. No entry will be accepted prior to the opening date. Entries will be accepted until 5 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information will be sent to the **first** player listed on this form when the field is filled or after entries close. Status may be checked weekly at www.thecga.org.

Entries must be returned to the Carolinas Golf Association, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. <u>Only one entry per check</u>. A meal for both players is included in the entry fee. Cart and range fees are not included in the entry fee. Competitors may walk but must pay a cart fee during practice and championship rounds. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of a verified player illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made for any reason on or after October 31.

Pairings and starting times will be posted at the club and at www.thecga.org the day before the championship. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.
