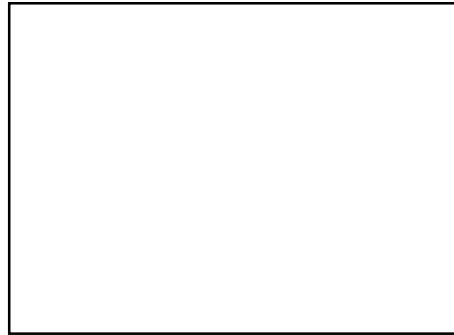


**3rd North Carolina Senior Partners

Champions: Tommy Langley, High Point
and Tom Hadley, Hendersonville**

A pair of CGA veterans, 71-year-old Tommy Langley and 67-year-old Tom Hadley counted a pair of pars on the last hole to nip the leaders of the first and second rounds, Tim Cook and Ernie Newton, by a shot.

The unique formatting of this championship lent itself to the drama of the finish. Cook and Newton shot an opening four-ball 64 for a two-shot lead. Playing a modified alternate-shot format the second day, they shot 67 and had a six-shot cushion over Langley and Hadley going into the last day. The format for the last day is individual stroke play, counting all shots. Langley and Hadley shot 145 to claim the crown. 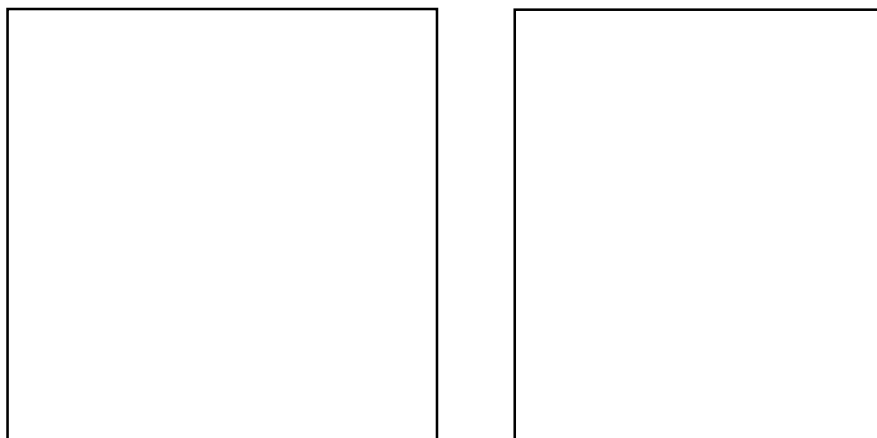
