Medalist, Abby Bools of Hickory, rolled through her first two opponents with very little trouble. But when she reached the finals she faced a tough opponent in Amber Littman of Stoney Creek. Littman, a 16 year old high school junior won 3 up with two holes left over Bools, a high school senior. Littman took control of the match going 4 up after ten holes, but Bools battled back winning holes eleven and twelve. Littman finished the match with an up and down par on the tough par three 16th. This is Littmans' first major CGA victory.
