**Champion: Ryan Sullivan, Winston-Salem**

Starting off a little shaky, Ryan Sullivan of Winston-Salem settled down his nerves to win the 2nd Dogwood State Junior Championship at Bermuda Run CC. Sullivan, who has verbally committed to play collegiate golf at UNC-Wilmington, started off with a bogey and then followed up with a double bogey on the first two holes. He played the next sixteen holes 1-under par to win by two shots over Tommy Gibson of Pilot Mountain and Lee Bedford of Cary. Sullivan finished at 212, 4-under par for the championship. After the round, Sullivan said, "I think I was just really nervous being in the lead going into the final round. After the double bogey I just told myself to calm down and play golf. I guess it worked for me."

Courtney Taylor of Gastonia played consistent golf to win by one shot over Colleen Estes of Cary to capture the 2nd Dogwood State Junior Girls' Championship. Taylor, a rising sophomore, shot a third round 75 for a three day total of 232. Taylor was the only competitor in the event to shoot all three rounds in the seventies. "I worked really hard on my game this summer," Taylor said "I am happy that all my hard work has paid off." Finishing in third was Courtney McKim of Raleigh, four shots back of Taylor. The Dogwood State Junior was renamed in 2006 from the Junior Championship of North Carolina. This is a three day stroke play event featuring some of the top junior girls in the state.
