The Virginias team defeated the Carolinas 20 1/2 to 15 1/2 to claim "The Captains Putter" in the Carolinas-Virginias Team Matches at the Country Club of Richmond. The Virginias win broke the Carolinas' three-year winning streak. The Virginias posted some early wins in the singles matches with shut outs in the first five matches which helped the team gain some momentum. The Virginias entered the day with a slim one-point lead but claimed a two-point win in the regular matches as well as the senior matches for their 5-point overall win. The Carolinas-Virginias Team Matches pits 24 golfers of North and South Carolina against 24 golfers from Virginia and West Virginia. The matches were reduced to four-ball and singles matches after inclement weather forced the cancelation of the alternate shot matches. A total 36 points were available with 18 1/2 needed for a win. This competition is conducted jointly by the Carolinas Golf Association, Virginia State Golf Association and West Virginia Golf Association.
