July 7-10, 2009 Champion: Parker Allen, Blythewood

Parker Allen of Blythewood, SC enjoys playing golf so much that it took him 22 holes to capture the 32nd SC Junior Boys Match Play Championship hosted by Rock Hill Country Club. Parker, 17, played three matches that went into extra holes. In the morning semifinals match, Allen defeated his high school teammate and neighbor Damon Postal, also of Blythewood, SC in 19 holes. Also advancing to the championship match was Cody Proveaux of Leesville, SC defeating qualifying medalist and home town favorite, Miles Curley of Rock Hill, SC by a margin of 4 & 3. In the championship match, both players traded birdies on the par five

13th hole. Allen then went 1 up by holing a 50 yard pitch for eagle on the par five 15th. Proveaux squared the match on the 17th hole with a par. On the 18th hole, Allen just missed a five footer that would have won the match. On the first extra hole, Proveaux had a chance for the win, but misread a four footer that broke out of the hole at the last minute. On the 22nd, Allen made his putt for birdie while Proveaux missed which gave the championship to Allen. This was Allen's first CGA title.
