The eight-golfer Virginias team won three of the final four singles matches against their Carolinas counterparts to post a two-point victory as the 28th Virginias-Carolinas Junior Matches concluded at the Country Club of Landfall's Pete Dye Course. One point was available per each match. Virginias owned a two-point advantage after the first day and that would help play an important role in the team scoring a 9-7 overall victory. Carolinas answered to take final-day singles matches,  $4\frac{1}{2}$ - $3\frac{1}{2}$ . All told, Virginias claimed its fourth straight win in the series and notched its second straight victory on North Carolina soil, having also triumphed in 2007 in the Tar Heel State. Virginias four-match win streak matches the longest string of victories by either team in the event's history, equaling Carolinas win run in the first four years of the series from 1983-86.

#### **David Parrott Award**



David Parrott was diagnosed with leukemia in the spring of 1982 and during his brief illness, he participated in the golf camp at Duke University and competed in the SCGA South Carolina Junior Championship, finishing third in his flight.

He was given the Derek Davis sportsmanship award at the championship for his effort, determination and inspiration he gave to all who knew him. David died July 29, 1982 at the age of 16.
