New Grooves Rule Condition of Competition in Effect for U.S. Amateur Contestants

In Sectional Qualifying and in the Championship proper, the player's clubs must conform to the groove specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010. The condition of competition is available for review on the U.S. Open Championship entry application. The USGA and R&A have created a reference resource called the Informational Club Database to assist golfers in determining whether their irons, hybrids and fairway woods comply with the New Grooves Rule Specifications. *Penalty for Carrying, But Not Making Stroke with, Club or Clubs in Breach of Condition: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – Four strokes.

*Penalty for Making Stroke with Club in Breach of Condition: Disqualification

Distance Measuring Devices

In Sectional qualifying and in the Championship proper, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. To see a video and learn more about conformance issues related to the Local Rule, visit <u>www.usga.org/dmd</u>.

Transportation

Players must not ride on any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorized by the Committee. The optional condition prescribed in Appendix I of The Rules of Golf will be in effect.

Format, Qualifying Spots, 18-Hole Cut and Playoffs-TBD

U.S. Amateur Championship sectional qualifying is 36 holes of stroke play, 18 each day. You are required to walk in all phases of the championship including qualifying rounds. Due to this qualifier taking place over 2 days, there will be an 18-hole cut. After 18 holes, the field will be cut to the low 30% of the field plus ties and anyone within 8 strokes of the last qualifying spot for the final round on July 9. Final round is an 8:00am start paired by score.

3 qualifying spots and 2 alternate positions. There are 100 competitors in the field. An on-course hole-by-hole playoff is used to determine the last qualifying spot or an alternate position as soon as the need is determined. Players are responsible for making themselves available at the scoreboard for playoff instructions.

Caddies, Pull-Carts and Caddie Carts

You are responsible for providing your own caddie. Caddies will <u>NOT</u> be available at the club. Players may carry their own bag during the qualifying round. Private pull-carts <u>are</u> allowed. Caddies will be allowed to rent a cart for the qualifying round at this site for \$25.00. However, <u>caddies will have to share carts</u> during the qualifying round as not more than two carts are allowed per group.

Qualifying Rounds Range Fee

Range balls are complimentary on July 8-9 for all contestants.

Practice Round

You are entitled to <u>one</u> practice round on June 13-July 7 when tee times are available. There is a <u>mandatory</u> \$35.00 cart/range fee for the practice round. You may call the golf shop five days in advance to schedule a practice round tee time. Make sure to identify yourself as a U.S. Amateur Championship qualifying participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. See "Course Yardage" section for course set-up and tee locations.

USGA Policies (Spectator Carts, One-Ball Rule, Spike Policy)

The USGA does not allow spectator carts or spectators to ride in a caddie cart during qualifying rounds or the championship proper for any reason. <u>Traditional metal spikes are not allowed.</u> The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification. Qualifying Schedule

June 13-July 7Course available for practice rounds when tee times are available. Call golf shop in advance for starting time.Friday, July 8Round 1: 18 holes of stroke play. Cut to low 30% and anyone within 8 strokes of last position.Saturday, July 9Round 2: 18 holes of stroke play. Playoffs for qualifying spots and alternates immediately following play.

Pace of Play Policy

A player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds is subject to a warning and will be so advised. The player will be notified that exceeding 40 seconds on one more occasion will result in a penalty of one stroke. A third violation will result in a two stroke penalty, followed by disqualification. A player's time to play begins when he has had a reasonable opportunity to reach his ball and when it is the player's turn to play and can do so without interference or distraction. Penalties are applied individually, but more than one competitor in a group may be penalized.
