# New Grooves Rule Condition of Competition in Effect for U.S. Mid-Amateur Contestants

In Sectional Qualifying and in the Championship proper, the player's clubs must conform to the groove specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010. The condition of competition is available for review on the U.S. Open Championship entry application. The USGA and R&A have created a reference resource called the Informational Club Database to assist golfers in determining whether their irons, hybrids and fairway woods comply with the New Grooves Rule Specifications. \*Penalty for Carrying, But Not Making Stroke with, Club or Clubs in Breach of Condition: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – Four strokes.

\*Penalty for Making Stroke with Club in Breach of Condition: Disqualification

#### Distance Measuring Devices

In Sectional qualifying and in the Championship proper, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

# Transportation (Players Required to Walk) & Shuttles

Players must not ride on any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorized by the Committee. The optional condition prescribed in Appendix I of The Rules of Golf will be in effect.

#### Format

U.S. Mid-Amateur sectional qualifying is 18 holes of stroke play.

#### **Qualifying Spots and Playoffs**

7 qualifying spots and 2 alternate positions are available at this site. There are 120 players in the field. An on-course playoff is used to determine the last qualifying spot or an alternate position. Players are responsible for making themselves available at the scoreboard for playoff instructions.

#### Push-carts and Caddies

<u>Push-carts are allowed per club policy</u>. Caddies will <u>NOT</u> be available at The Club at Irish Creek. Players may carry their own bag during the qualifying round. Caddies will be allowed to rent a cart for the qualifying round at this site. Caddie cart fee is \$25.00 on the qualifying date.

### **USGA Policies and Spectator Carts**

The USGA prohibits the use of cellular phones during qualifying and championship rounds except as a distance measuring device. Traditional metal spikes are <u>NOT</u> allowed. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification. The "One-Ball" rule will be in effect. Spectator carts are not allowed except for persons with a bona fide handicap issue. We will do our best to accommodate any handicap spectator cart requests. The requesting person must show proof of a handicap (i.e. handicap car plaquard), a cart must be available and the person must pay the \$25 cart fee. Handicap spectator cart requests must be made in advance to the CGA office. Spectators are not permitted to ride in a caddie cart during the qualifying round.

# Practice Round and Qualifying Round Fees

You are entitled to <u>one</u> practice round from August 1-5 when tee times are available. There is a <u>mandatory</u> \$35.00 cart/range fee for the practice round. You may call starting July 25 to schedule a practice round tee time. Do not show-up and expect to be accommodated for a practice round without calling first. Make sure to identify yourself as a U.S. Mid-Amateur Championship qualifying participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. See "Course Yardage" section for practice round tee locations.

There are no other fees due to the host club on the qualifying date unless a side rents a caddie cart. Range balls are complimentary and will be set on the range on the qualifying date.

### Food and Beverage

The club will have food and beverage service available at the building near #1 tee.

# Qualifying Schedule

August 1-7	Practice rounds available.
August 8	Qualifying Round: 18 holes of stroke play.
-	Playoffs for qualifying spots and alternates immediately following play.
August 9	Rain Date (if necessary)

Pace of Play Policy A group that is out of position will be advised of the situation and the individuals may be timed. The players will be notified that exceeding 40 seconds to play their next shot will result in a penalty of one stroke. A second violation will result in a two stroke penalty, followed by disqualification for a third violation.

A player's time to play begins when the player has had a reasonable opportunity to reach his or her ball and when it is the player's turn to play and can do so without interference or distraction. Penalties are applied individually, but more than one competitor in a group may be penalized.

Pace of play guidelines are listed on the player's scorecard.
