## 2019 CGA Interclub (REGULAR and SENIOR) Entry Form

Entries for the annual Carolinas Interclub competition are now open. This competition features neighboring member clubs competing amongst each other in match play net competition. 62 teams competed in the 21<sup>st</sup> REGULAR Interclub Season in 2018 while 83 teams battled it out for the 2<sup>nd</sup> SENIOR Interclub title.

### Format:

- REGULAR Interclub team competition involves 8 players from each team competing in "four-ball" match play format. Minimum age is 18. Matches are played primarily on weekends.
- SENIOR Interclub team competition involves 8 players from each team competing in "four-ball" match play format. Minimum age is 55. Matches are played primarily on weekdays.
- Both leagues play home and away (6 total) matches during the regular season (April 1 – July 28).
- Both leagues will use each player's 12 month LI (Low Index).
- Eighteen (18) match points will be available in each four-ball match (1 point per hole). A total of 72 match points are available in each team match. A team winning the majority of points (36½) will earn a win in the POD. A team win will result in 2 "season" points towards their POD standings. Matches ending in a tie will result in 1 "season" point each.
- 1st and 2nd place teams from a typical four team POD will advance to a single elimination playoff format for each league. A 3rd team is invited from Pods with six teams. A limited number of "wild card" playoff spots will also be awarded based on won/loss records and accumulated match points. The "Final Four" teams from each league will compete for their respective championship at pre-determined sites and dates hosted by the CGA. Both Championship sites and dates will be announced in February.

### Captains Meeting:

Pre-season Captain's meetings to review Interclub/Match play rules, pairings, etc., will be held at various locations in North and South Carolina. Each participating club captain **MUST ATTEND** a pre-season Captain's meeting.

### Entry Form:

- Teams should pre-form their own groups/pods. PLEASE CONFIRM WITH THE OTHER CLUBS BEFORE LISTING THEIR NAMES ON THE ENTRY FORM AS PART OF YOUR GROUP/POD. Clubs that sign up individually will be assigned (if possible) to a group/pod by the CGA.
- Entry forms and fees must be submitted by mail or email. The entry deadline is March 1 (*April 1 for mountain clubs closed for the winter*). Entry fee for both leagues is \$300 per team (\$250 per team if submitting more than one team; the entry fee for a club entering one Regular Team and one Senior Team is \$500). The Carolinas Interclub is a service of the Carolinas Golf Association and is open to any male member of a CGA member club in both North and South Carolina.
