

The 52nd Junior Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 18th birthday by the last day of the championship, is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, and whose parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules will be distributed at the starter's table. The Carolinas Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. **Caddies over the age of 17 are not permitted.**

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play for the 12-13, 14-15, and 16-17 divisions and 27 holes stroke play for the 11 and under division. The 12-13 and 11 and under divisions will play a shortened course. The champion is the low scorer in the two upper age groups. After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the low half and ties in each age division. All 11 and under players will qualify for the final round.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the winners, second-place and third-place finishers in each division. The low four scorers in the 14-17 division qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Team Matches, August 18-19, 2001 at Boonsboro Country Club in Lynchburg, Virginia. *The M.K. Jeffords Trophy* will be held by the winner of the boys 14-17 division for the ensuing year.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. No entry will be accepted prior to the opening date. Entries will be accepted until 5 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information will be sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.thecga.org.

Entries must be returned to the Carolinas Golf Association, P.O. Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Fax, telephone, late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check.

Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of a verified player illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made for any reason on or after July 27.

EXEMPTIONS AND QUALIFYING

11 and under: First 12 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date.

12-13: First 24 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date.

14-17: Any players making the cut at the 2000 CGA Junior (see reverse) regardless of age division and those players ranked lowest by the NC and SC Junior rankings as of July 23, 2001 who filed applications with the CGA office by July 23 up to a total of 107. **Qualifying:** Those not included in the above categories will have the opportunity to qualify July 30, 2001 at Greensboro National Golf Club in Summerfield, North Carolina. A minimum of seven spots will be available.

Schedule of Play at Greensboro Country Club

Monday, July 30	Course open for practice. Qualifying for non-exempt players at Greensboro National Golf Club in Summerfield, NC.
Tuesday, July 31	First round: 18 holes of stroke play for older divisions and nine holes for 11 and under age divisions.
Wednesday, August 1	Second round: Same format as Tuesday. Older divisions cut.
Thursday, August 2	Final round.

Pairings and starting times will be posted at the club the day before the championship. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.
