

The 34th North Carolina Junior Boys and Girls Championships of the Carolinas Golf Association

**June 19-22, 2001
Old North State Club
New London, NC**

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any amateur golfer who has not reached his or her 18th birthday by the last day of the championship, is a legal resident of North Carolina, and whose parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules will be distributed at the starter's table. The Carolinas Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. **Caddies over the age of 17 are not permitted at any time during either the championship or practice rounds.**

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at match play. There will be an 18-hole stroke-play qualifying round to determine match play qualifiers and seedings.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists, quarterfinalists and medalist in the boys 14-17 age division; to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists and medalist in the boys 13 and under age division; and to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists, quarterfinalists and medalist in the girls' division. The champion and runner-up of the boys' 14-17 age division qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Boys Team Matches, August 18-19, 2001 at the Boonsboro Country Club in Lynchburg, Virginia. *The Harry L. Welch Trophy* will be held by the winner for the ensuing year by the boys 14-17 champion. *The Linda Marsh Trophy* will be held by the winner for the ensuing year by the girls champion.

ENTRIES

Each player must complete an official entry form. No entry will be accepted prior to the opening date. Entries will be accepted until 5 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors and/or delays by any mail courier. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information will be sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.thecga.org.

Entries must be returned to the Carolinas Golf Association, P.O. Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Fax, telephone, late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of a verified player illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made for any reason on or after June 15.

EXEMPTIONS AND QUALIFYING

Boys 14-17: All players who made match play in the 2000 NC Junior (see reverse side) regardless of age division are exempt. Additionally, the highest ranked players on the NC Junior Rankings as of June 11, 2000 will be exempt until the field reaches 91 exempt players. If fewer than 91 of these players enter the championship, entrants with the lowest handicap indexes will be exempt until a total of 91 is reached. All exempt players must enter within the above deadline (see open/close dates at top of entry form). **Qualifying:** Those players not included in the above categories will play a qualifying round on June 18 at Piney Point Golf Club in Norwood, NC. A minimum of five spots will be available. The first 28 entries in the **boys 13 and under division** to reach the CGA office after the opening date will be accepted into the field. The first 32 entries in the **girls division** to reach the CGA office after the opening date will be accepted into the field.

Schedule of Play at the Old North State Club

Monday, June 18	Course open for practice. Championship qualifying for non-exempt players at Piney Point Golf Club in Norwood.
Tuesday, June 19	18-hole qualifying round for match play (all players)
Wednesday, June 20	Boys 14-17: First and second round matches. Boys 13 & under: First and quarterfinal round matches (9 holes). Girls: First round matches.
Thursday, June 21	Boys 14-17: Third round and quarterfinal matches. Boys 13 & under: Semifinal (9 holes) and final matches (18 holes). Girls: Quarterfinal and semifinal matches.
Friday, June 22	Boys 14-17: Semifinal and final matches. Girls: Final match.

Pairings and starting times will be posted at the club the day before the championship. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.
