ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any female (at birth) amateur golfer who is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, is 50 years of age or older as of the first day of the championship, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association and has a current CGA handicap index. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules will be distributed at the starter's table. The Carolinas Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including the alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Dress Code: No cut-off shorts or denim, no shorts shorter than four inches above the knees, no tank tops or t-shirts, and all shirts must have either a collar or sleeves. *Note: During the stipulated round, use of cell phones, pagers, beepers and the like will NOT be allowed.*

FORMAT

The championship will be contested at 36-hole stroke play with four age divisions: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, and 65 & older. All players will be eligible for the overall championship.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the champion, second and third place finishers in each age division. The champion of the 65 & older division will be the Super Senior Champion. The low North Carolina and low South Carolina scorers will be awarded prizes.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. No entry will be accepted prior to the opening date. Entries will be accepted until 5 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information will be sent to players after the field is filled or entries close.

Entries must be returned to the Carolinas Golf Association, P.O. Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Fax, telephone, late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Daily cart fees are not included in the entry fee.

Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of a verified player illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made for any reason on or after April 6.
