Keith Waters becomes the first player to win the NC Four-Ball with two different partners. And Greg Powell is the first person to win the Carolinas Four-Ball and the North Carolina Four-Ball in the same year. Powell said, "Keith came through for

me at the times I was out of the hole." Their score of 195 (21-under par) is the third-lowest total in the event's nine-year history.
