

# 2<sup>nd</sup> Dogwood State Junior Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

## ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male or female amateur golfer who has not reached his or her 19<sup>th</sup> birthday by the last day of the championship, has not started college, is a legal resident of North Carolina; and the junior golfer, parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA). Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at [www.carolinagolf.org](http://www.carolinagolf.org).

## RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Each competitor must walk and carry his/her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be 18 or younger and must walk. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

## CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT AND YARDAGES

The championship is conducted at 54-holes of stroke play for the girls' division, boy's 14-15 division, and boy's 16-18 division and 27-holes of stroke play for the 11 and under age division. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low half and ties in each division. All 11 and under players qualify for the final round. The following yardage's are used in each age division: Boy's 14-15 and Boy's 16-18 divisions - approx. 6900 yards, Boy's 12-13 and Girls' divisions - approx. 5700 yards, 11 & under divisions - approx. 2500 yards (9-holes only).

## PRIZES AND TEAM MATCHES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, and first runner-up in each division. The overall boy's champion will qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Boy's Team Matches, August 19-20, 2006 at Chapel Hill CC in Chapel Hill, NC. The girls' champion qualifies to represent the CGA in the 2007 Mid-Atlantic Challenge, as long as she meets the eligibility requirements.

## ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at [www.carolinagolf.org](http://www.carolinagolf.org). No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at [www.carolinagolf.org](http://www.carolinagolf.org). Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future CGA Junior championships.

## REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made regardless of reason for players who have played in a qualifier. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

## EXEMPTIONS AND QUALIFYING

### Exemptions:

Girls: First 30 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date regardless of division. NO QUALIFYING

Boys 11 and under: First 12 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date. NO QUALIFYING

Boys 12-13: First 24 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date. NO QUALIFYING

Boys 14-18: The top 75 ranked players on the TYGA NC Junior rankings as of June 10, 2006 and all players who made the cut in the 2005 Dogwood State Junior Championship who have filed applications with the CGA office by July 12, 2006.

Qualifying: In the Boys 14-18 division only, those not included in the above categories have the opportunity to qualify on July 20, 2006 at Gaston CC in Gastonia, NC and on August 1, 2006 at Asheboro CC in Asheboro, NC. Final qualifying numbers will be determined after entries close.
