

57th Junior Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 19th birthday by the last day of the championship, has not started college, is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas; and the junior golfer, parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA). Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinagolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The Carolinas Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Each competitor must walk and carry his/her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be 18 or younger and must walk. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play for the 12-13, 14-15, and 16-18 divisions and 27 holes of stroke play for the 11 and under division. The 12-13 and 11 and under divisions play shortened courses. The champion is the low scorer in the two upper age groups. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low half and ties in each age division. All 11 and under players qualify for the final round.

PRIZES AND TEAM MATCHES

The *M.K. Jeffords Trophy* is held by the winner of the boy's 14-18 division for the ensuing year. Trophies are awarded to the winner, second-place and third-place finishers in each division. The low three scorers in the 14-18 division qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Team Matches, August 19-20, 2006 at Chapel Hill CC in Chapel Hill, NC. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the overall champion.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinagolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinagolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future CGA Junior championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made regardless of reason for players who have played in a qualifier. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

Detach, sign and mail the entry form with your fee to CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Entry fee is \$50. Incomplete, illegible forms and entries received before the opening date are returned. Keep the bottom portion for your records.

EXEMPTIONS AND QUALIFYING

11 and under: First 18 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date. NO QUALIFYING

12-13: First 30 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date. NO QUALIFYING

14-18: Any players making the cut at the 2005 CGA Junior (see reverse) regardless of age division and those players ranked in the top 50 of the TYGA NC and SCJGA SC Junior rankings as of June 1, 2006 who filed applications with the CGA office by June 28, 2006.

Sectional Qualifying - 18 Holes. The number of qualifying places at each qualifying site is determined by the CGA after entries close, based on the size of the field. If a qualifying site attracts more players than can be accommodated, some players are assigned to another site or rejected. Assignment or rejection is based on the date the CGA receives each entry form and cannot be changed. Site assignments cannot be changed after entries close. Individual qualifying site information is sent after entries are accepted. A player may choose to qualify at only one site. If that qualifying site is full at the time the entry is received, that player is listed as an alternate at that qualifying site.

*CC of Orangeburg qualifying site - A Carolinas Junior qualifier is held in conjunction with the first round of the SC Junior Match Play Championship. Players may compete in both events as long as entries have been filed for both. There is space available for those wishing to qualify who are not competing in the SC Junior Match Play Championship.
