ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinascgolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 54 holes of four-ball stroke play. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low 30 teams and ties for the final round. Ties for prizes are split except for the overall championship, which is determined by an on-course playoff.

PRIZES

The championship team receives merchandise and trophies. The top 15 teams and ties receive merchandise.

GOLF CARTS

Daily cart fees are not included in the entry fee. Cart rental may be mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors may walk or rent golf carts during championship rounds. Competitors are responsible for paying cart rental fees prior to each championship round. Caddies are permitted.

ENTRIES

Each team must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinascgolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. Entries are accumulated for the entire open/close window. Exempt teams are accepted at time of entry. The remainder of the field is selected after entries close by team index and past CGA tournament record. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to the first player listed on this form when the field is filled or after entries close. Status may be checked at www.carolinascgolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Daily cart fees are not included in the entry fee. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future N.C. Four-Ball championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, illness or death in the family. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

Detach, sign and mail the entry form with your fee to CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Entry fee is \$120. Incomplete, illegible forms and entries received before the opening date are returned. Keep the bottom portion for your records.

EXEMPTIONS

Exempt players, if otherwise eligible, include: champions of the North Carolina Four-Ball Championship since 1997 and teams that finished 15th or better in the 2005 North Carolina Four-Ball Championship. Exempt team members must compete on the same team or with another exempt player.

Tee times available for practice.

Friday, October 27
First round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play. Half the field at each course.

Saturday, October 28
Second round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play. Field changes courses.
Field cut to low 30 teams and ties for final round.

Sunday, October 29
Final round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play on the West course.
