

39th North Carolina Junior Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male or female (at birth) amateur golfer who has not reached his or her 19th birthday by the last day of the championship, has not started college, is a legal resident of North Carolina; and the junior golfer, parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA). Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinagolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Each competitor must walk and carry his/her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be 18 or younger and must walk. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT AND YARDAGES

The championship is conducted at match play. There is an 18-hole stroke-play qualifying round to determine match play qualifiers and seedings. The following yardages are used in each age division: Boy's 14-18 - approx. 6650 yards, Boy's 13 and under & Girls' - approx. 5700 yards.

PRIZES AND TEAM MATCHES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists and medalist in the boy's 14-18 age division; to the champion, runner-up and medalist in the boy's 13 and under age division; and to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists, and medalist in the girls' division. *The Harry L. Welch Trophy* is held for the ensuing year by the boy's 14-18 champion. *The Linda Marsh Trophy* is held for the ensuing year by the girls' champion. The champion and runner-up of the boy's 14-18 age division qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Boy's Team Matches, August 19-20, 2006 at Chapel Hill CC in Chapel Hill, NC. The girls' champion and runner-up qualify to represent the CGA in the Mid-Atlantic Challenge, August 5-6, 2006 at Independence Golf Club in Midlothian, VA.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinagolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinagolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future NC Junior championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made regardless of reason for players who have played in a qualifier. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

Detach, sign and mail the entry form with your fee to CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Entry fee is \$50. Incomplete, illegible forms and entries received before the opening date are returned. Keep the bottom portion for your records.

EXEMPTIONS AND QUALIFYING

Exemptions:

Girls: First 36 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date. Amber Littman of Stoney Creek is the girls' defending champion and will be seeded number one for match play if otherwise eligible.

Boys 13 and under: First 32 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date.

Boys 14-18: Any players making the second round of match play (top 32) in the boy's 14-18 age and the top 4 in the boy's 13 and under division at the 2005 NC Junior (see reverse) and the top 75 ranked players on the May 2006 TYGA NC Junior rankings who have filed applications with the CGA office by June 2.

David Chung of Fayetteville is the boy's defending champion and will be seeded number one for match play if otherwise eligible.

Qualifying: In the Boy's 14-18 division only, those not included in the above categories have the opportunity to qualify June 12, 2006 at Cedarwood CC in Charlotte, NC or June 12 at Gates Four CC in Fayetteville, NC. A minimum of ten spots will be available at each site. The final qualifying numbers will be determined after entries have closed.
