

13th North Carolina Mid-Amateur Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

September 15-17, 2006

River Landing (River), Wallace, NC



Open Date: Monday, July 3

Entry Fee: \$80

Close Date: Monday, July 31

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his 30th birthday by the first day of the championship, is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinagolf.org. The maximum allowable handicap index is 5.4.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play. After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the low 60 scorers and ties.

PRIIZES

Prizes are awarded in merchandise at the championship and at qualifying sites. The *P.J. Boatwright Trophy* is held by the winner's club for the ensuing year. A tie for the overall championship is resolved using an on-course playoff.

GOLF CARTS

Daily cart fees are not included in the entry fee. Caddies are allowed for sectional qualifying and championship rounds.

Sectional Qualifying: Cart fee is mandatory for sectional practice and qualifying rounds.

Championship Site: Cart rental may be mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors may walk or rent a golf cart during championship rounds.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinagolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinagolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future N.C. Mid-Amateur championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made regardless of reason for players who have played in a qualifier. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

Detach, sign and mail the entry form with your fee to CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Entry fee is \$80. Incomplete, illegible forms and entries received before the opening date are returned. Keep the bottom portion for your records.

EXEMPTIONS AND SECTIONAL QUALIFYING

Exemptions: Exempt players from sectional qualifying, if otherwise eligible, include: champions of the Carolinas Amateur since 1996, champions of the North Carolina Mid-Amateur since 1996, champions of the Carolinas Mid-Amateur since 2001, champions of the North Carolina Amateur since 2001, champions of the CGA South Carolina Amateur Match Play since 2001, the 2005 Carolinas Senior Amateur champion, the 2006 North Carolina Senior Amateur champion, the 2006 Carolinas Amateur runner-up, non-senior/junior playing members of the 2005 Carolinas Team, players who finished 30th or better in the 2005 North Carolina Mid-Amateur, and players ranked in the Top 20 of the CGA Carolinas Men's Amateur Rankings as of 7/3/06. Also, current USGA individual champions, 2005 USGA Championship qualifiers, most recent Walker Cup team members, and the current club champion of River Landing as of the opening date are exempt in addition to any special exemption the CGA may wish to bestow.

Sectional Qualifying - 18 Holes. The number of qualifiers' places at each qualifying site is determined by the CGA after entries close based on the size of the field. All ties for the final qualifying position qualify for the championship. If a qualifying site attracts more players than can be accommodated, some players are assigned to another site or rejected. Assignment or rejection is based on the date the CGA receives each entry form and cannot be changed. Site assignments cannot be changed after entries close. Individual qualifying site information is sent after entries are accepted. A player may choose to qualify at only one site. If that qualifying site is full at the time the entry is received, that player is listed as an alternate at that qualifying site.
