ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male or female (at birth) amateur golfer who has not reached his or her 19th birthday by the last day of the championship, has not started college, is a legal resident of South Carolina; and the junior golfer, parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA). Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinasgolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Each competitor must walk and carry his/her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be 18 or younger and must walk. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at match play. There is an 18-hole stroke-play qualifying round to determine match play qualifiers and seeding order. Drew Ernst of Seneca and Emily Rapp of Simpsonville are the defending champions and are seeded number one if otherwise eligible.

PRIIZES AND TEAM MATCHES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists and medalist in the boy's 14-18 age division; to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists and medalist in the boy's 13 and under age division; and to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists and medalist in the girls' division. The champion and runner-up of the boy's 14-18 age division qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Boys Team Matches, August 19-20, 2006 at Chapel Hill CC in Chapel Hill, NC. The girls' champion and runner-up qualify to represent the CGA in the Mid-Atlantic Challenge, August 5-6, 2006 at Independence CC in Richmond, VA. *The James T. Worley Trophy* is held for the ensuing year by the boy's 14-18 champion. *The Jane Crum Covington Trophy* is held for the ensuing year by the girls' champion.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinasgolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future SC Junior match play championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, illness or death in the family. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

Boys 14-18: Third round and quarterfinal matches.

Boys 13 & under: Semifinal (9 holes) and final matches (18 holes).

Girls: Second Round (if necessary)* and Quarterfinal matches.

Friday, July 14

Boys 14-18: Semifinal and final matches.

Girls: Semifinal (if necessary)* and Final match.

*Number of players (16 or 32) in girls' draw will be determined by number of entries.
