

45th Senior Amateur Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

September 12-14, 2006

Cape Fear Country Club, Wilmington, NC



Open Date: Monday, July 10

Entry Fee: \$80

Close Date: Monday, August 7

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his 55th birthday by the first day of the championship, is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinagolf.org. The maximum allowable index is 10.4 for championship division and 15.4 for super senior division (70 and over).

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are **NOT** allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play. After 36 holes, the field is cut to low 60 scorers and ties for the final round. The super senior division competes at 36 holes of stroke play with no cut and plays a shorter course. Players who are age 70 and over and who meet the handicap requirement may opt to play in the championship division but waive any right to prizes in the super senior division. The super senior division is re-paired according to score after the first round. Field size: Championship (120 approximately); Super Senior (24 lowest indexes).

PRIZES

Champion receives a trophy, merchandise and possession of the permanent championship trophy for the ensuing year. The super senior champion receives a trophy and merchandise. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the overall champion or super senior champion.

GOLF CARTS/CADDIES

Daily cart fees are **not** included in the entry fee. Competitors are responsible for paying appropriate fees prior to each round. Caddies are allowed for sectional qualifying and championship rounds.

Sectional Qualifying: Cart fee is mandatory for sectional practice and qualifying rounds.

Championship Site: Cart rental **may** be mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors **may** walk or rent a golf cart during championship rounds.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinagolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinagolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future Carolinas Senior Amateur championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made regardless of reason for players who have played in a qualifier. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from **all** refunds.

Detach, sign and mail the entry form with your fee to CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Entry fee is \$80. Incomplete, illegible forms and entries received before the opening date are returned. Keep the bottom portion for your records.

EXEMPTIONS AND SECTIONAL QUALIFYING

Championship Division Exemptions: Championship division players exempt from sectional qualifying, if otherwise eligible, include: champions of the Carolinas Senior Amateur since 1996, champions of the North Carolina Senior Amateur since 1996, champions of the SCGA South Carolina Senior Amateur since 1996, players who finished 30th or better at the 2005 Carolinas Senior Amateur, individual champions of CGA and SCGA championships since 2001, players who finished top 10 at the 2006 North Carolina Senior Amateur, players who finished top 10 at the 2006 SCGA South Carolina Senior Amateur, senior playing members of the 2005 Carolinas Team, 2005 Carolinas Men's and Senior Men's Player of the Year, and players ranked in the Top 40 of the CGA Carolinas Senior Men's Amateur Rankings as of 7/10/06. Also, current USGA individual champions, 2005 USGA Championship qualifiers and the current senior club champion of Cape Fear Country Club as of the opening date are exempt in addition to any special exemption the CGA may wish to bestow.

Super Senior Division Exemption: The 2005 Carolinas Super Senior champion is exempt into the Super Senior division.

Sectional Qualifying - 18 Holes. Sectional qualifying is only for the Championship division. The number of qualifiers' places at each qualifying site is determined by the CGA after entries close, based on the size of the field. All ties for the final qualifying position qualify for the championship. If a qualifying site attracts more players than can be accommodated, some players are assigned to another site or rejected. Assignment or rejection is based on the date the CGA receives each entry form and cannot be changed. Site assignments cannot be changed after entries close. Individual qualifying site information is sent after entries are accepted. A player may choose to qualify at only one site. If that qualifying site is full at the time the entry is received, the player is listed as an alternate at that one qualifying site or re-assigned to his second or third choice qualifying site based upon availability.
