

38th Senior Four-Ball Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

April 25-27, 2006

Tanglewood Park (Championship), Clemmons, NC

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his 55th birthday by the first day of the championship, is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinascgolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 54 holes of four-ball stroke play. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low 30 teams and ties for the final round.

PRIZES

The field is pre-flighted by total team index. After 36 holes, prizes are awarded to top finishers in each flight; and the field is cut to the low 20 teams and ties, regardless of flight, for the final round. All ties for flight prizes are split. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the overall champions. The championship team receives trophies and merchandise.

GOLF CARTS

Daily cart fees are not included in the entry fee. Cart rental may be mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors may walk or rent golf carts during championship rounds. Competitors are responsible for paying cart rental fees prior to each championship round.

ENTRIES

Each team must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinascgolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. Entries are accumulated for the entire open/close window. Exempt players are accepted at time of entry. The remainder of the field is selected after entries close by team index and past CGA tournament record. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to the first player listed on this form after entries close. Status may be checked at www.carolinascgolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, illness or death in the family. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

EXEMPTIONS

Exempt players, if otherwise eligible, include: champions of the Carolinas Senior Four-Ball Championship since 1996 and teams that finished 15th or better at the 2005 Carolinas Senior Four-Ball Championship. Exempt team members must compete on the same team or with another exempt player.
