

# 56<sup>th</sup> Carolinas Four-Ball Championship

## ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at [www.carolinascgolf.org](http://www.carolinascgolf.org).

## RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

## FORMAT AND PRIZES

Championship format is 36 holes of four-ball stroke play to determine 32 qualifiers for four-ball match play. The defending champions are seeded number one for match play if otherwise eligible. The championship team receives merchandise, trophies and names inscribed on the *Hale Van Hoy Trophy*. Stroke play qualifying medalists names will be encribed on the *Joe B. McCarley Cup*. Additional prizes are awarded to all match play contestants.

## GOLF CARTS AND RANGE FEES

Daily cart and range fees are not included in the entry fee. Cart rental may be mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors have the option to either walk or rent golf carts during championship rounds. Competitors are responsible for paying cart rental fees prior to each championship round.

## ENTRIES

Each team must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at [www.carolinascgolf.org](http://www.carolinascgolf.org). No entry will be accepted prior to the opening date. **Entries will be accumulated for the entire open/close window. Exempt teams are accepted at time of entry. The remainder of the field will be selected after entries close by total team index.** Entries will be accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information will be sent to the **first** player listed on this form when the field is filled or after entries close. Status may be checked at [www.carolinascgolf.org](http://www.carolinascgolf.org). Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) will jeopardize their entry into future Carolinas Four-Ball championships.

## REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, player illness or death in the family. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

Exempt players, if otherwise eligible, include: champions of the Carolinas Four-Ball Championship since 1997 and teams that qualified for match play in the 2006 Carolinas Four-Ball Championship. Robert Dargan of Columbia, SC and David Dargan of Columbia, SC are the defending champions and will be seeded number one for match play if otherwise eligible. Exempt team members must compete on the same team or with another exempt player.

## Championship Schedule

### **Tuesday, May 1**

Tee times available for practice.

### **Wednesday, May 2**

First round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play qualifying.

### **Thursday, May 3**

Second round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play qualifying. Field cut to low 32 teams for match play.

### **Friday, May 4**

First and second rounds of four-ball match play (18 holes each round).

### **Saturday, May 5**

Quarterfinal and semifinal rounds of four-ball match play (18 holes each round).

### **Sunday, May 6**

Final match (18 holes).
