ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his 55th birthday by the first day of the championship, is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinagolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

FORMAT AND PRIZES

The championship format is 54 holes of four-ball stroke play. The field is pre-flighted by total team index. After 36 holes, prizes are awarded to top finishers in each flight and the field is cut to the low 30 teams and ties for the final round. All ties for flight prizes are split. An on-course playoff is used to break a tie for the overall championship. The championship team receives trophies and merchandise.

GOLF CARTS AND RANGE FEES

Daily cart and range fees are not included in the entry fee. Cart rental may be mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors have the option to walk or rent golf carts during championship rounds. Competitors are responsible for paying cart rental fees prior to each championship round.

ENTRIES

Each team must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinagolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. **Entries are accumulated for the entire open/close window. Exempt players are accepted at time of entry. The remainder of the field is selected after entries close by total team index.** Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to the **first** player listed on this form after entries close. Status may be checked at www.carolinagolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, player illness or death in the family. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.
