

41st Twin States Junior Girls' Championship

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any female amateur golfer who has not reached her 19th birthday by the last day of the championship, has not started college, is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas; and the junior golfer, parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA). Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinagolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The Carolinas Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Each competitor must walk and carry her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be **18 or younger** and must walk. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

JUNIOR DIVISION

Junior division will be made of any girl 13 years of age or older, or under the age of 13 with a handicap index less than 15.0.

SUB-JUNIOR DIVISION

Sub-junior division will be made of any girl less than 13 years of age with a handicap index of 15.0 or higher. Players in the sub-junior division will play 9-holes each day.

FIELD SIZE

The field will be limited to 72 juniors and 12 sub juniors. Entry acceptance will be determined by handicap index, and past tournament participation. A waiting list will be formed with remaining entries. E-mail notification of acceptance or waiting list status, will be sent after the close of entries.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT AND YARDAGE

The championship is conducted at 36-holes of stroke play. The field will be flighted after round one. The championship flight will be made up of the top 16 players and ties from round one. All other flights will have approximately 8 players. The junior division will play from a yardage of approx. 5875 yards. The sub junior division will play from approx. 5134 yards.

PRIZES AND TEAM MATCHES

Trophies will be awarded to the champion and runner-up in the junior division, the champions, runner-up and second runner-up in each junior division flight, the winner, runner-up and second runner-up in the sub junior division, the medalist from round one in each division and the most improved in each division. The overall champion will be invited (if still eligible) to represent the Carolinas on the Carolinas Junior Girls' team that will compete in the **2008** Mid-Atlantic Challenge at Independence GC in Midlothian, VA.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinagolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinagolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future CGA Junior championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made regardless of reason for players who have played in a qualifier. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from **all** refunds.
