ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 19th birthday by the last day of the championship, has not started college, is a legal resident of one of the Carolinas; and the junior golfer, parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA). Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinascgolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The Carolinas Golf Association reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Each competitor must walk and carry his/her own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be **18 or younger** and must walk. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. Note: The use of cellular phones (except in the case of an emergency), portable music devices, headphones, laptop computers, PDA's, pagers, beepers, and the like are not allowed during a stipulated round. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play for the 12-13, 14-15, and 16-18 divisions and 27 holes of stroke play for the 11 and under division. The 12-13 and 11 and under divisions play a shortened course. The champion is the low scorer in the two upper age groups. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low half and ties in each age division. All 11 and under players qualify for the final round.

PRIZES AND TEAM MATCHES

The *M.K. Jeffords Trophy* is held by the winner of the 14-18 division for the ensuing year. Trophies are awarded to the winner, second-place and third-place finishers in each division. The low two scorers in the 14-18 division qualify to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Team Matches, August 9-10, 2008 at the Club at Irish Creek in Kannapolis, NC. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the overall champion and a tie for a position on the Carolinas junior team.

ENTRIES

Each entrant must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications can be completed at www.carolinascgolf.org. Fax, email, telephone, incomplete, illegible forms, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date are not accepted. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinascgolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry fee per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. Detach, sign and mail the entry form with your \$50 entry fee to the CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future CGA Junior championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, player illness or death in the family. Refunds are not made regardless of reason for players who have played in a qualifier. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

EXEMPTIONS AND QUALIFYING

11 and under: First 18 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date. **NO QUALIFYING**

12-13: First 30 entries to reach the CGA office after the opening date. **NO QUALIFYING**

14-18: Any players making the cut at the 2007 CGA Junior (see reverse) regardless of age division and those players ranked in the top 50 of the TYGA NC and SCJGA SC Junior rankings as of June 9, 2008 who filed applications with the CGA office by the closing date.

Sectional Qualifying - 18 Holes. Qualifying: In the Boys' 14-18 age division only, those not included in the above categories have the opportunity to qualify June 21 at CC of Orangeburg in Orangeburg, SC or July 23 at Whispering Woods GC in Whispering Pines, NC. A minimum of ten spots will be available at each site. The final qualifying numbers will be determined after entries have closed.
