ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any team comprised of a male golf professional who is a member of the club's golf professional staff employed by a Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) Member Club and a male amateur golfer who is a member in good standing of the same CGA Member Club. The amateur partner must be a legal resident of one of the Carolinas and have a current USGA handicap index® at the same CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. **Only one team entry is allowed per member club.** For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinagolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round at any time during the championship. Note: During the stipulated round, use of electronic telecommunications equipment and the like are NOT allowed. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been presented.

FORMAT

The championship is conducted at 18 holes of four-ball stroke play with no handicap. A tie for the overall champions is decided by an on-course play-off. All other ties will be split.

PRIZES

The purse and prize distribution is determined by the number of entries. Amateurs receive merchandise certificates. The permanent trophy is displayed at the winning team's club until the next championship. Professionals and amateurs share equally in the prize distribution.

GOLF CARTS/RANGE FEES

Championship round cart and range fees are included in the entry fee. Practice round cart rental may be mandatory and is not included in the entry fee. Competitors may walk or ride golf carts during the championship round.

ENTRIES

Each team must complete an official entry form. Teams may complete an online application at www.carolinagolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, incomplete and illegible forms, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date are not accepted. **Entries are accumulated for the entire open/close window after which the final field will be selected by the amateur's handicap index and CGA championship record.** The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to the Amateur listed on this form when the field is filled or after entries close. Status may be checked at www.carolinagolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. Only one team entry fee per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. Detach, sign and mail the entry form with your fee to CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. Entry fee is \$200 and includes championship round cart fees. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future Carolinas Pro-Amateur Club championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if the CGA is notified before close of entries. Refunds are not made after entries close except in the case of player injury, player illness or death in the family. A \$20 administrative fee is deducted from all refunds.

EXEMPTIONS

Exempt players, if otherwise eligible, include: champions of the Carolinas Pro-Amateur Club Championship since 1998. Both winning team members must compete together. To be exempt, the amateur partner must retain amateur status and meet all eligibility requirements.
