The eight-golfer Virginias team won five of eight final day singles matches against their Carolinas counterparts to claim the 26th Virginias-Carolinas Junior Matches at The Club at Irish Creek. One point per match was available. With the matches tied 4-4 after the first day, Virginias outscored the Carolinas 5-3 in singles to record a 9-7 victory. Virginias claimed its second straight win in the series and notched its first win on Carolinas soil in the matches since 2004 when the team triumphed at The Old North State Club in New London, N.C. The matches annually rotate between Virginias and Carolinas sites.

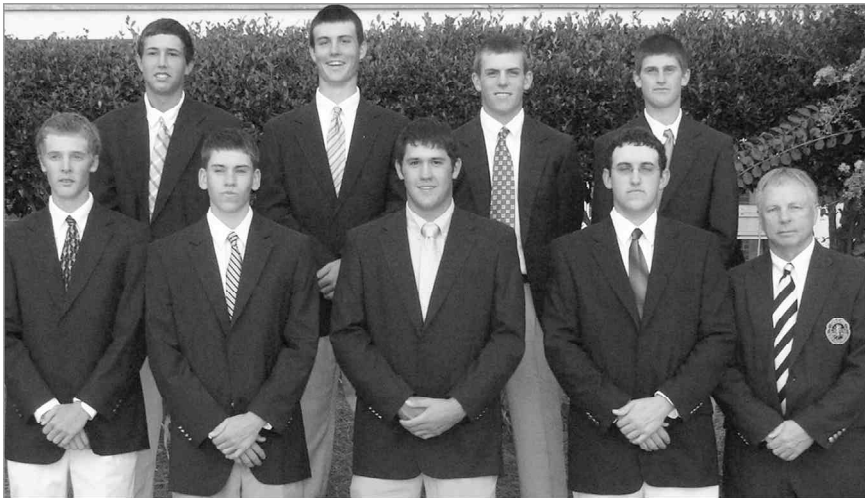

David Parrott Award

The David Parrott award is given annually to the Carolinas Team player who displays excellence in sportsmanship, ability, and academic excellence. The award is presented by Dr. Larry Parrott of Camden, SC in memory of his son David.

David Parrott was diagnosed with leukemia in the spring of 1982 and during his brief illness, he participated in the golf camp at Duke University and competed in the SCGA South Carolina Junior Championship, finishing third in his flight.

He was given the Derek Davis sportsmanship award at the championship for his effort, determination and inspiration he gave to all who knew him. David died July 29, 1982 at the age of 16.
