Hayley Hammond of Mooresville captured her first CGA Championship crown defeating Jessica Hook of Wilmington by a 2 & 1 margin. Hammond, a high school senior, birdied Bradford Creek's 16th hole to take a 1 up lead and then closed out the championship match on the 17th hole with a two-putt for a par. "The pressure of match play is very intense," said Hammond. "I was 3 up through 11, but Jessica chipped away at my lead to get it back to all square after 15 holes. I was shaking! I was so nervous and was ready to get the match over with, one way or another. I am pretty excited that I won."
