ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any team comprised of a parent and child in any age combination **excluding male-male**. Step-parents and grandparents are allowed. At least one member of each team must be a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, be a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA), have a current USGA handicap index® at a CGA member club or is a golf professional employed at a CGA member club. A team is eligible if one partner is an amateur member of a CGA member club or if one partner is a golf professional employed by a CGA member club. **Pro-Pro teams and in-laws are NOT eligible.** Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. The minimum age for entry is eight years as of the tournament date. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinagolf.org.

ENTRIES

All teams must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications may be completed at www.carolinagolf.org. **Fax, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.** Entries are accumulated for the entire open/close window. The final field is comprised of the teams with the lowest team handicap indexes (as computed under "FORMAT" section). Alternate teams are ranked according to team handicap index. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance and tournament information is sent to the **first** player listed on this form when their status has been determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinagolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. **Only one entry fee per check.** Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. Detach, sign and mail the entry form with the \$100 entry fee to the CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. A team whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Parent-Child Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Close Date: Full refund minus \$25.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Day after Close Date to day prior to Championship: 50% entry fee refunded regardless of reason.

Withdraw on Championship Date: No refund for any reason.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

COURSE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Championship round cart and range fees are included in the entry fee. Cart use is mandatory during the championship round.

Cart rental and use is mandatory for practice rounds.

Caddies are allowed for championship rounds. A player may provide his own caddie. Caddies will not be available at host club.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: During the play of a hole, either the player or his caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed.

FORMAT

Each team plays alternate shot except that both team members hit from each gender/age designated tee and then select the ball to be played. A team must then complete the hole with the ball selected. Teams are pre-flighted into divisions according to team handicap index. Team handicap index is computed by adding 2/3 of the lower handicap index to 1/3 of the higher handicap index. Golf professionals are scratch handicap for net team prizes and compete in the Open Division.

PRIZES

Merchandise and trophies are awarded to the overall champion. Merchandise is distributed in each division to low net winners based upon the number of entries. Ties for prizes are split except for the overall champion, which is determined by an on-course playoff.

EXEMPTIONS

There are no exemptions for this championship.
