



33rd South Carolina Junior Match Play Championship

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male or female amateur golfer who has not reached their 19th birthday by July 9, 2010, who has not started college, is a legal resident of South Carolina, is a member or their parent is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA). Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website (www.carolinascgolf.org).

ENTRIES

All players must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications may be completed at www.carolinascgolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted. Exempt players are accepted at time of entry. Non-exempt players gain entry into the qualifier on a first come first serve basis. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinascgolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry fee per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. Detach, sign and mail the entry form with the \$60 entry fee to the CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's SC Junior Match Play Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Close Date: Full refund minus \$25.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Day after Close Date to day prior to qualifier or Championship: 50% entry fee refunded regardless of reason.

Withdraw on qualifier or Championship Date: No refund for any reason.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

AGE DIVISIONS

Championship will be divided into three divisions: girls' (all ages), boys' 14-18 and boys' 13 and under.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists and medalist in each division.

TEAM MATCHES

The girls' champion will be invited to represent the CGA in the Mid-Atlantic Challenge Girls' Team Matches at Independence Golf Club in Midlothian, VA on July 31-August 1, 2010. The boys' 14-18 division champion will be invited to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Team Matches at CC of Landfall in Wilmington, NC on August 14-15, 2010.

FORMAT; YARDAGES

The championship format is match play with 18 holes of stroke play qualifying to determine the seedings for match play. Defending champions Elizabeth Thompson and Parker Allen will be seeded number 1 for match play. The top 63 boys from the stroke play qualifier will advance to match play. The top 15 girls from the stroke play qualifier will advance to match play. The top 16 in the boys' 13 and under will advance to match play. Boys' 14-18 division will compete at approximately 6,300 yards, par 70. Girls' and boys' 13 and under divisions will compete at approximately 5,800 yards, par 70.

EXEMPTIONS: QUALIFYING

Players in the following categories are exempt into the championship. Those boys ages 14-18 not exempt may gain entry into the championship proper by qualifying at the qualifier listed below.

Girls' Exemptions:

First 32 entries received by the closing date will be accepted.

No qualifying.

Boys' 13 and Under Exemptions:

First 32 entries received by the closing date will be accepted.

No qualifying.

Boys' ages 14-18 Exemptions:

1. Top 32 from 2009 CGA SC Junior Match Play Championship.
2. Top 8 from 2010 SCGA SC Junior Boys' Championship.
3. Top 4 from 2009 CGA SC Junior Match Play Boys' 13 and Under Championship.
4. Top 100 on the SCJGA SC Boys' Rankings as of May 12, 2010.
5. All 2010 SC High School State Individual Champions.

All exempt players must complete an official entry form by the closing date.

Boys' Qualifying:

In the Boys 14-18 division only, those not included in the above categories have the opportunity to qualify on July 1 at the Golf Club of South Carolina @ Crickentree in Blythewood, SC. A minimum of ten spots will be available from the qualifier. The final qualifying numbers will be determined after entries have closed.
