Dress Code: Shirts must have a collar (mock neck is not permissible), shirts must be tucked-in; hat brims face forward, no denim, no cargo pants or cargo shorts, soft-spike shoes. Policy is for players, caddies and spectators.

Coolers: Personal coolers are not allowed.

Cell Phones: Except for emergencies and rulings and viewing tournament leaderboard, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot. Please turn your phone to silent-mode when on club property.

Golf Shop: Cash, MasterCard, Visa

Food & Beverage: Cash only.

## Championship Format and Schedule

Championship format is 36 holes of stroke play to determine 32 qualifiers for match play. The defending champion is seeded number one for match play if otherwise eligible. Players advancing to match play will receive merchandise and are exempt into the 2014 North Carolina Amateur Match Play Championship.

Tuesday, July 30

Tee times available for practice rounds. Must call golf shop in advance.

Wednesday, July 31

Stroke Play Qualifying Round 1. Tee times at 8:00am & 12:30pm off #1 & #10 tees.

Thursday, August 1

Stroke Play Qualifying Round 2. Tee times at 8:00am & 12:30pm off #1 & #10 tees.

Cut to low 32 scores for match play. Playoff for medalist and last match play position.

Friday, August 2

Round of 32 (AM) and Round of 16 (PM) match play (18 holes each round).

Saturday, August 3

Quarterfinal (AM) and semifinal (PM) rounds of match play (18 holes each round).

Sunday, August 4

Championship match (18 holes).

Awards ceremony immediately following play at scoreboard.

## Starting Times

Starting times for July 31-August 1 will be available on Friday, July 26 by 5:00pm. Check the CGA website at [www.carolinasgolf.org](http://www.carolinasgolf.org), call the CGA office or Carolina CC golf shop.

## Practice Rounds

You are entitled to one practice round from July 23-28 and July 30 when tee times are available. You may call the Carolina CC golf shop beginning July 16 to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a North Carolina Amateur Match Play Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a mandatory \$25.00 cart & range fee for the practice round.

## Championship Cart and Range Fees

*Stroke Play Qualifying Rounds:* Contestants opting to use a golf cart must pay host club a \$20.00 per player, per round cart fee. Club will collect both qualifying round cart fees on July 31. Contestants may choose to walk during championship rounds without any additional fees to the host club. Range fee is paid by the CGA for all players for stroke play qualifying rounds.

*Match Play Rounds:* Contestants may use a golf cart or walk during match play rounds. Cart and range fees for match play rounds will be paid by the CGA.

### Caddies and Spectators

Caddies are permitted but during the play of a hole, either the player or the caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are welcome at CGA championships however they are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time or rent a spectator cart except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual for a bona fide handicap issue. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed. Due to the limited number of available carts, spectator carts may not be available on July 31-August 1.

### Pull-Carts

Personal pull-carts are allowed.

### Food and Beverage

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Carolina CC. The downstairs bar in the clubhouse and halfway house will be open to service all food needs. **Club accepts Cash only for any food and beverage purchases.** Water fountains and coolers are located throughout the golf course.

### Lodging

Lodging is available at the Hampton Inn & Suites Raleigh/Crabtree Valley (919-881-7080) located at 3920 Arrow Drive, Raleigh, NC. Hotel is located approximately 5 minutes from Carolina CC. Hotel offers free high-speed Internet access and free continental breakfast each morning. Please use Group Code: **Carolinas Golf Association** to receive the discounted rate of \$115.00 + tax for a King room or 2 Queen room on July 30-August 1 and \$99.00 rate on August 2-3. **Hotel room block is held until July 12.** Rooms after the cutoff date are on a space available basis. ### Directions to Carolina Country Club and Hampton Inn & Suites

*To Carolina CC from I-440/US 1 (Raleigh Beltline):* Take Glenwood Avenue/Downtown/Hwy 70 East exit towards downtown Raleigh (exit 7 Northbound, 7A Southbound). Go 1.5 miles. Club entrance on left.

*To Hotel from Carolina CC:* Turn right out of club onto Glenwood Avenue. After passing under I-440 get in far left lane. At Blue Ridge Road/Leadmine Road intersection stoplight make a U-turn. Take the 2nd right onto Arrow Drive. Hotel will be on the left.

### Tournament Policies

Carolina Country Club is a spikeless facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification. Any player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a penalty of one stroke. A second violation will result in a two stroke penalty, followed by disqualification.

Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect. Note that if a smartphone or tablet is used as a distance measuring device, the device must not contain apps that would render it non-conforming such as a compass or level app. The "Notice to Players" rules sheet is available on the North Carolina Amateur Match Play Championship home page.
