Your entry into the 6<sup>th</sup> North Carolina Super Senior Championship at Carolina Trace Country Club (Lake Course) on September 24-25, 2013 has been received and accepted. Please review the following championship information since there is no formal championship registration at Carolina Trace. Remember that we are guests of the club and we need to conduct ourselves in a proper manner. Also, make sure to be at your assigned cart ready to play 15 minutes prior to the shotgun start each day. Locker Room: The men's locker room will be available to players during the championship.

Dress Code: Shirts must have a collar (mock neck is OK if 1 ½ inches in height), no denim, no cargo shorts or cut-off shorts, soft-spike shoes.

Coolers: Personal coolers are permitted.

### Starting Times

Starting times for September 24 will be available beginning Thursday, September 19<sup>th</sup> by 5:00pm. Check the CGA website at [www.carolinasgolf.org](http://www.carolinasgolf.org); call the CGA office or the Carolina Trace golf shop. Practice facility will open 1 hour prior to the first tee time each morning.

### Practice Round/Golf Carts/Pull-Carts/Caddies/Spectators

You are entitled to one practice round on September 1 - September 23 when tee times are available. You may call the Carolina Trace golf shop starting September 1 to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a North Carolina Super Senior Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a mandatory \$25.00 cart/range fee for the practice round.

Championship round cart/range fees and final round lunch are included in the entry fee. Players are required to use golf carts at this event therefore pull-carts and walking are NOT permitted.

CGA Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: Caddies are permitted but since players are required to use a cart at this event then caddies must walk. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual.

### Accepted Forms of Payment

Club accepts cash, check, MasterCard, Visa and Discover for practice round cart & range fees, golf shop purchases and food & beverage.

### Food & Beverage

Food & beverage will be available to contestants inside the pro shop. CGA will provide lunch for all players following play on September 25.

### Tipping

The CGA encourages players to tip club personnel particularly the outside staff when a service is performed (i.e. placing clubs on carts, cleaning clubs, etc.).

### Lodging

Host hotel is the Holiday Inn Express Sanford (919-776-6600). Hotel is located 15 minutes from Carolina Trace. Hotel serves complimentary breakfast and offers high-speed Wi-Fi Internet access. Please identify yourself with **Group Code: CGA** to receive the discounted rate of \$89.00 + tax for a King room or a Double room. **Hotel room block is held until September 13.** Rooms will be subject to availability and standard rates after the cut-off date. Hotel has a 24 hour cancellation policy.

### Championship Format and Schedule

Championship is conducted at 36 holes of stroke play. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the overall championship. Prizes will be awarded to the top-30 overall finishers.

Monday, September 23 Course available for practice rounds.

Tuesday, September 24 First Round: 8:00am double tee start. Repair field according to score for final round.

Wednesday, September 25 Final Round: 9:30am shotgun start. Hosted lunch and awards immediately following play.

### Tournament Policies

Carolina Trace Country Club is a spikeless facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification. Except for emergencies, rulings and viewing tournament leaderboard, use of cell phones during play is prohibited. Any player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a warning. A second violation will result in a one stroke penalty; third violation will result in a two stroke penalty followed by disqualification. CGA will post your adjusted gross scores from this championship to your home club handicap.

Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect. Note that if a smartphone or tablet is used as a distance measuring device, the device must not contain apps that would render it non-conforming such as a compass or level app. The "Notice to Players" rules sheet is available on the North Carolina Super Senior Championship home page.
