Your entry into the 2nd Carolinas Super Senior Four-Ball Championship at Greensboro Country Club in Greensboro, NC on October 15-16, 2013 has been accepted. The championship will be played on the Irving Park course. Please review the following championship information since there is no formal championship registration at Greensboro Country Club. Remember that we are guests of the club and we need to conduct ourselves in a proper manner. Also, make sure to be at your assigned tee ready to play a few minutes before your tee time. Dress Code: Shorts must be Bermuda-length, shirts must have a collar and be tucked in at all times. No denim of any kind is allowed.

Cell Phones (revised for 2013): Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice or texting communications and play is not delayed. Except for emergencies, rulings and viewing tournament leaderboard, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot.

Starting Times

Starting times for October 15 will be available on **Tuesday, October 8**. Check the CGA website at www.carolinasgolf.org, call the CGA office or Greensboro Country Club golf shop. The official starting time clocks are located on the starting tees.

Practice Round, Carts and Range Fees, Pull-Carts

You are entitled to one practice round on Monday, October 14. You may call the golf shop starting October 7 to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a Carolinas Super Senior Four-Ball Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a **mandatory** \$25.00 cart/range fee for the practice round.

New for 2013: All championship cart & range fees are included in the entry fee and will be paid by the CGA to the host club.

Contestants must use a cart during championship rounds. Pull-carts are **NOT** allowed.

Greensboro Country Club golf shop cash or check only for practice round fees and golf shop purchases.

Practice Facility

The practice range at the Irving Park course is limited to shots of 150 yards or less. You will be allowed to use the practice range at the Farm Course which is approximately 20 minutes away. **Greensboro CC – Farm Course address is: 5121 Hedrick Dr., Greensboro, NC 27410**

Food and Beverage, Awards Luncheon on October 16

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Greensboro Country Club. Food and beverage will be available for championship contestants in the club's "Halfway House". Club accepts **cash only** for food and beverage purchases. Personal coolers are not allowed.

CGA will host an awards luncheon for all players immediately following play on Wednesday, October 16.

Championship Format and Schedule

Championship is conducted at 36 holes of four-ball stroke play. Top 15 overall teams receive merchandise at the conclusion of the championship. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the championship.

Monday, October 14 Practice rounds. Must call golf shop in advance for tee time.

Tuesday, October 15 First Round: 9:00am shotgun start. Repair field according to score for final round.

Wednesday, October 16 Final Round: 9:00am shotgun start. Hosted lunch and awards immediately following play.
