Your application for entry into the **87th Carolinas Women's Amateur Championship** at Treyburn Country Club in Durham, NC on **May (20) 21-23, 2013** has been received and accepted. Please review the following championship information. Please be sure to be at your assigned tee at least **5** minutes prior to your starting time.

Starting Times

Starting times for Tuesday, May 21 will be available on Friday, May 17 after 5:00pm. Check the CGA web site at www.carolinanagolf.org, call the CGA office or the Treyburn Country Club golf shop. **Thursday, May 23** will be a 9:00am shot-gun start.

Practice Round

You are entitled to **one** practice round on Monday, May 20th. You may call the Treyburn golf shop to schedule a practice round beginning **Tuesday, May 14 – NO EARLIER**. Make sure to identify yourself as a Carolinas Women's Amateur Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a **mandatory** \$25 cart/range fee for the practice round. Cart/range fee for **each** championship round is included in your entry fee. Cart fee is mandatory for the practice round. All players **MUST** use a cart during the championship rounds. Championship players will play the CGA tees throughout the championship (approximately 5900 yards). There will be a separate Carolinas division. Carolinas division players will play the club's red tees throughout the championship (approximately 5250 yards).

Registration

Player registration will take place on Monday, May 20 from 9:00am-4:00pm in front of the main clubhouse entrance. Players not able to register on Monday should register Tuesday, May 21 in the morning.

Lodging

Championship headquarters will be the Hampton Inn – Durham I-85. The Hampton Inn is offering a discount rate of \$109 plus tax per night which includes breakfast. Please identify yourself with the **Carolinan Golf Association (CGA)** to receive the special rate. **PLEASE** call **ASAP** to book your reservation. Rates available based on room availability

Championship Format

The championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play (no cut). All players regardless of handicap index have the option to play the "Championship Division" (approximately 5900 yards) or the "Carolinan Division" (approximately 5250 yards). Overall Champion and Senior Champion (age 50+) will be determined from contestants playing in the Championship Division. Super Senior Champion (age 65+) will be determined from contestants playing in the Carolinas Division. Field is divided into flights within divisions according to score after 36 holes.

Spike Policy

Treyburn Country Club is a spikeless facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

Slow Play

Any player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a warning for slow play and will be advised of the fact. The player will be notified that exceeding 40 seconds on one more occasion will result in a penalty of one stroke. A third violation will result in a two stroke penalty, followed by disqualification. ***It's important to keep up with the group in front of you at all times.**

Distance Measuring Devices

Local rule allowing the use of distance measuring devices during the championship will be in effect. Note that if a Smartphone or tablet is used as a distance measuring device, the device must not contain apps that would render it non-conforming such as a compass or level app.

Locker Room Usage

Lockers will be available to players throughout the week. Please check-in the golf shop to get a key and a locker assignment. Showers are also available.

Bag Storage

Bag storage will be available for all contestants throughout the week. Please make sure your name is clearly identified on your bag. If you choose to use this service gratuities are encouraged and appreciated. You may leave your clubs on the cart at the end of each day. The golf staff will take care of all your equipment.

Food and Beverage

Food and beverage items will be available throughout the championship. Items may be purchased from the golf shop area as well. Water, ice and cups will be located on the driving range. Drinks/Snacks will be located on #1 and #10 tee.

Tuesday, May 21 - The CGA will host a cook-out luncheon and cash bar for all players in the family grill and brick patio area.

- *Any additional guests should buy tickets at registration. *Check or cash is accepted for ticket purchases.*
- Fee is: \$16.00. Make check out to CGA.

Wednesday, May 22 – Players on their own. Players and guests are welcome to eat off the grill menu in the clubhouse.

Thursday, May 23 – Awards Luncheon for all players in the family grill and brick patio area.

- *Any additional guests should buy tickets to attend at registration. *Check or cash is accepted for ticket purchases.*
- Fee is: \$18.00 Make check out to CGA.

Caddies and Spectators

Spectator carts are not allowed. All spectators must be prepared to walk.

Exception 1: The CGA will grant a person with a bona fide physical handicap a spectator cart if the following conditions are met: 1. Host club has a golf cart available; 2. Handicapped person pays host club the appropriate cart fee; 3. Handicapped person presents to the CGA staff or CGA representative a handicap card issued by a government agency.

Caddies are allowed but must also walk and will be required to wear a caddie bib. All players are required to use a cart in this championship.
