Locker Room: Locker rooms will be available to players during the championship.

Dress Code/Coolers: Shirts must have a collar (mock neck is OK if 1 ½ inches in height), no denim, spikeless shoes. **No personal coolers.**

Starting Times

Groupings and hole assignments for November 22 will be available beginning **Tuesday, November 18**. CGA will email hole assignments to players and will also be available on the web (<http://www.ghintpp.com/carolinasgolf/TPPOnlineScoring/Pairings.aspx?ID=748>), by calling the CGA, SCGA or WSCGA offices. A 10:00am shotgun start will be used each round.

Practice Round/Golf Carts/Pull-Carts/Caddies/Spectators

You are entitled to **one** practice round on November 21 when tee times are available. You may call the Pinehurst Resort & Country Club golf shop at 910-295-3186 starting November 16 to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a Carolinas Net Amateur Championship participant. Pinehurst Resort hotel guests may reserve a practice round starting time when booking a room. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a **mandatory** \$35.00 cart/range fee for the practice round. **Championship round cart/range fees and cocktail party are included in the entry fee.** Players are required to use golf carts at this event therefore pull-carts and walking are **NOT** permitted.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: Caddies are permitted but during the play of a hole, either the player or his caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual. Since players are required to use a golf cart, caddies will be required to walk.

Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual for persons with a bona fide handicap issue. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Accepted Forms of Payment

Club accepts cash, MasterCard, Visa, Discover and American Express for cart/range fees, golf shop purchases and food/beverage.

Food/Beverage & Cocktail Party Social

Food and beverage will be available to contestants in the clubhouse Donald Ross Grill, 91st Hole snack bar and halfway house on the golf course. Associations will host a cocktail party social for all players following play on November 22 in the clubhouse. Appetizers, tea and beer will be available for players only. Guests must pay for their own food and beverage items at either the Donald Ross Grill or 91st Hole.

Tipping

We encourage players to tip club personnel particularly the outside staff when a service is performed (i.e. placing clubs on carts, cleaning clubs, etc.).

Lodging

Pinehurst Resort is offering a discounted hotel rate of \$109.00 plus tax and service charges from November 21-23. Please call the toll free number at 800-487-4653, and select option 3. Reference the "CGA" or "Carolinas Golf Association" to receive the discounted rate. Hotel guests may reserve a practice round starting time when booking a room reservation.

There are several other lodging options in the Pinehurst area. Associations have a \$72.00 single or double rate set-up at the Comfort Inn (910-215-5500). Comfort Inn is located on Hwy 15-501. Ask for the "Carolinas Net Amateur Rate". Other area lodging includes the Homewood Suites-Pinehurst Olmstead Village (910-255-0300) or the Pine Crest Inn (910-295-6121).

Championship Format and Prizes

The championship is 36 holes of net stroke play using 100% Course Handicap. Net Score is calculated by subtracting Course Handicap from Gross Score. Players are assigned into flights within divisions by net score following the first round.

Overall champion in each division (Men, Women, Senior Men, Senior Women, Super Senior Men, Super Senior Women) receives a trophy and merchandise. Merchandise will be awarded to the top finishers in each flight based upon the number of entrants.

A tie for the overall champion in each division is determined by an on-course three hole playoff using 1/6 course handicap rounded to the nearest whole number. If a tie remains then co-champions will be declared. All other ties are broken on the score card using the USGA recommended method.

Merchandise certificates are valid for one year.

Championship Schedule

Friday, November 21	Course available for practice rounds. Must call in advance for starting time.
Saturday, November 22	First Round: 10:00am shotgun start. Re-pair and flight field within divisions according to net score for final round. Cocktail party immediately following play in the Pinehurst clubhouse.
Sunday, November 23	Final Round: 10:00am shotgun start. Awards ceremony immediately following play at scoreboard.

Score Posting

Associations will post your adjusted gross scores from this championship to your home club handicap.

Championship Policies

Pinehurst R&CC is a soft-spike facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

Any player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a penalty of one stroke. A second violation will result in a two stroke penalty, followed by disqualification.

Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect (i.e. measure distance only). Note that if a smartphone or tablet is used as a distance measuring device, the distance measuring application must measure distance only and the device must not have any other applications that would render the device non-conforming (i.e. GPS altimeter or anemometer). Compass and weather applications are now permitted on the device.
