Your entry into the 42nd South Carolina Amateur Match Play Championship at Seabrook Island Club (Ocean Winds) on June 4-8, 2014 has been received and accepted. Please review the following championship information since there is no formal championship registration at the club. Remember that we are <u>guests</u> of the club and we need to conduct ourselves in a proper manner. Also, make sure to pay any appropriate fees in the golf shop prior to each round and be at your assigned tee ready to play at least five minutes before your starting time. All championship site cart and range fees are included in the entry fee and paid by the CGA. Players have the option to walk or use a golf cart.

Dress Code/Coolers: Shirts must have a collar, no denim, hats face forward, spikeless shoes. No personal coolers.

Cell Phones: Except for emergencies, a ruling, viewing tournament leaderboard or use as a distance measuring device, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot. Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice or texting communications and play is not delayed.

Accepted Forms of Payment: MasterCard, Visa, Discover and American Express. NO CASH!

Personal Items: Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the CGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Championship Format and Schedule

Championship format is 36 holes of stroke play to determine 32 qualifiers for match play. The defending champion is seeded number one for match play if otherwise eligible. Trophy and merchandise is awarded to the runner-up and stroke play qualifying medalist. Players advancing to match play will receive merchandise and are exempt into the 2015 South Carolina Amateur Match Play Championship.

Starting Times

Starting times for June 4-5 will be available beginning Thursday, May 29. Check the CGA website at <u>www.carolinasgolf.org</u>. You may also call the CGA office or the club golf shop. The event will be a two-tee 8:00am start on Wednesday and Thursday.

Practice Rounds

You are entitled to <u>one</u> practice round on May 27-June 3 when tee times are available. You may call the Seabrook Island golf shop to schedule a practice round starting one week prior. Make sure to identify yourself as a South Carolina Amateur Match Play Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game with other contestants before calling. There is a <u>mandatory</u> \$25.00 cart/range fee for the practice round.

Championship Cart and Range Fees

The CGA will pay range fees/cart fees for all players during the Championship. Contestants may choose to walk during championship rounds. Club accepts <u>MasterCard, Visa, American Express, and Discover</u> for golf shop fees and purchases, NO CASH. Private pull carts are NOT allowed. Pull carts are available at Seabrook Island for a fee of \$11.50.

CGA Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy

Caddies are permitted but during the play of a hole, either the player or the caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are welcome at CGA championships however they are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time or rent a spectator cart except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed. Due to the limited number of available carts, spectator carts will not be allowed for any reason on June 4-5.

Food & Beverage

Seabrook Island is a private facility, when using food and beverage on the island; identify yourself with the SC Amateur Match Play. Food and beverage will be available to contestants in the Locker Room Lounge and in the Pelican's Nest for dinner. Breakfast is NOT available at the club or Pelican's Nest. Club accepts Cash, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, and Discover for food & beverage purchases, NO CASH.

Tipping

The CGA encourages players to tip club personnel particularly the outside staff when a service is performed (i.e. placing clubs on carts, cleaning clubs, etc.).

Tournament Policies

Seabrook Island is a soft spike facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

Any player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a warning. In stroke play qualifying, a second violation will result in a one-stroke penalty; third violation will result in a two-stroke penalty followed by disqualification. In match play, a second violation loss of hole; third violation is loss of hole followed by disgualification. is

Distance Measuring Devices: Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect (i.e. measure distance only). Note that if a smartphone or tablet is used as a distance measuring device, the distance measuring application must measure distance only and the device must not have any other applications that would render the device non-conforming (i.e. GPS altimeter or anemometer). Compass and weather applications are now permitted on the device.

Text Notifications: The Carolinas Golf Association has a new text (SMS) notification feature in the TPP tournament software that will be used to send text messages to your mobile phone in the event of tournament schedule changes, delays and cancelations. This is a free service provided by the CGA. Note that standard texting and data rates apply based upon your cell phone plan.
