Starting Times

Each round will use a 9:00am shotgun start. Groupings and hole assignments for July 21 will be available beginning <u>Thursday, July 17</u> by 5:00pm. Check the CGA website at www.carolinasgolf.org, call the CGA office or the High Meadows golf shop. Practice facility will open 1 hour prior to the first tee time each morning.

Practice Round/Golf Carts/Pull-Carts

You are entitled to <u>one</u> practice round from July 1-20 when tee times are available. You may call the High Meadows golf shop starting July 1 to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a Carolinas Super Senior Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a <u>mandatory</u> \$25.00 cart/range fee for the practice round.

Championship round cart/range fees and final round lunch are included in the entry fee. Players are required to use golf carts at this event therefore pull-carts and walking are <u>NOT</u> permitted.

Caddies & Spectators

CGA Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: Caddies are permitted but since players are required to use a cart at this event then caddies must walk. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual. Due to the limited number of golf carts, spectator carts may not be available for any reason.

Accepted Forms of Payment

Club accepts cash, MasterCard and Visa for practice round cart & range fees, golf shop purchases and food & beverage.

Food & Beverage

Food & beverage will be available to contestants inside the Hummingbird Grille from 8:00am-4:00pm daily. CGA will provide lunch for all players following play on July 22.

Cell Phones

Except for emergencies, a ruling, viewing tournament leaderboard or use as a distance measuring device, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot. Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice or texting communications and play is not delayed.

Tipping

The CGA encourages players to tip club personnel particularly the outside staff when a service is performed (i.e. placing clubs on carts, cleaning clubs, etc.).

Personal Items

Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the CGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Distance Measuring Devices

Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect (i.e. measure distance only). Note that if a smartphone or tablet is used as a distance measuring device, the distance measuring application must measure distance only and the device must not have any other applications that would render the device non-conforming (i.e. GPS altimeter or anemometer). Compass and weather applications are now permitted on the device.

Championship Format and Schedule

Championship is conducted at 36 holes of stroke play. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the overall championship. Prizes will be awarded to the top-30 overall finishers. Gift certificates expire on December 31, 2014.

July 1-20 Course available for practice rounds (must call in advance for starting time).

Monday, July 21 First Round: 9:00am shotgun start. Repair field according to score for final round.

Tuesday, July 22 Final Round: 9:00am shotgun start. Hosted lunch and awards immediately following play.

Tournament Policies

High Meadows Golf & Country Club is a spikeless facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

Any player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a warning. A second violation will result in a one stroke penalty; third violation will result in a two stroke penalty followed by disqualification.

CGA will post your adjusted gross scores from this championship to your home club handicap.

Text Notifications
