## Format

Tar Heel Cup consists of two days of competition. Day 1 format is Four-Ball Match Play. Day 2 format is Singles Match Play. Each match is worth 1 point each. A halved match earns each side ½ point. Since we are the defending champions, we need 6 points to retain the Cup. CPGA needs 6 ½ points to win.

## **Team Uniforms**

CGA will provide each team member with two shirts (solid white (Adidas), blue w/ white stripes (Adidas), a white pullover (Adidas) and 2 hats (Royal Blue and White). Plan to wear navy pants and gray pants. You may pick-up your uniform in the CCNC golf shop beginning at 10:30am on Monday. Let's plan to take a team photo with uniforms on at 11:00am outside the CCNC golf shop.

Daily Uniforms:

Monday: White shirt, Navy pants, Royal Blue hat.

Tuesday: Blue/white striped shirt, Gray pants, White Hat.

## Starting Times

Day 1 Four-Ball starting times begin at 12:00pm off #1 tee. Pairings will be announced about one week from the event. Day 2 singles starting times will run from 8:00am-8:56am off #1 tee. Day 2 matches and starting times will be announced at the Monday night dinner.

## **Practice Round and Course Fees**

A complimentary practice round is available on Sunday, March 23 after 12:00pm for Tar Heel Cup participants. Call the CCNC golf shop to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a Tar Heel Cup participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There are no course fees for the practice round or competition rounds.

#### Food and Beverage

A food and beverage tab will be available for Tar Heel Cup contestants at the snack bar and halfway house on March 24-25. Tell the attendant you are with the Tar Heel Cup Matches. Personal coolers are not allowed.

CGA and CPGA will host cocktails and dinner on Monday night at the Warren House for both teams. Dress is golf casual. Cocktails at 6:15pm with dinner at 7:00pm.

Each team will have its own house at CCNC that are located adjacent to each other near the practice facility.
