SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Thursday, October 15

Registration (11:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.) – Players register and receive additional information and their team uniforms at this time. Registration will be at the golf shop.

Practice rounds – Practice rounds are available after 12:00pm. Players may call the golf shop starting October 8 for a starting time. You may want to call other teammates to create your own group. Practice round fees are covered by the associations.

Lunch: Club salad bar in the Family Grill will be available for participants from 11:30am-2:00pm compliments of Old Town Club. Snacks and drinks will be available for cash purchase in the golf shop.

Casual Dinner (7:00 p.m. cocktails; 7:45 p.m. dinner) – Golf attire. Dinner and cocktails will be served in the Pool Pavilion. The associations will cover the cost of dinner and drinks. Both teams and one guest per player are invited.

OTHER INFO

- Tipping is allowed on the property.
- Carts will be paid for by the golf associations (including the Practice Round). Players will be required to use a golf cart. Caddies will not be available.
- Golf shop accepts Visa/MasterCard for merchandise purchases; Cash only for snack purchases.
- Hats must NOT be worn when inside any building.
- Cell phones are prohibited inside buildings and when playing other than as a distance measuring device, emergency or a ruling is needed. Otherwise, they may be used with discretion outside of the buildings.
- Players are encouraged to use the locker room to change clothing or shoes.
- Bag storage is available at no cost.
- Dress code is collared shirts, no cut-offs, no jeans, no tank tops, no cargo shorts, no cargo pants, Bermuda length shorts.
- Soft spiked golf shoes only.
- Private coolers are not allowed.
- Spectator carts are not allowed.
