Starting Times

Monday and Tuesday will be a 10:00am shotgun start. Groupings and hole assignments for September 28 will be available beginning **Tuesday, September 22** by 5:00pm. Check the CGA website at www.carolin'sgolf.org, call the CGA office or the Chapel Hill CC golf shop. Practice facility will open 1 hour prior to the first tee time each morning.

Practice Round/Golf Carts/Pull-Carts

You are entitled to one practice round from September 27 after 1:00pm when tee times are available. You may call the Chapel Hill CC golf shop starting September 20 to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a North Carolina Super Senior Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a mandatory \$25.00 cart/range fee for the practice round.

Championship round cart/range fees and final round lunch are included in the entry fee. Players are required to use golf carts at this event therefore pull-carts and walking are NOT permitted.

Caddies & Spectators

CGA Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: Caddies are permitted but since players are required to use a cart at this event then caddies must walk. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual. Due to the limited number of golf carts, spectator carts may not be available for any reason.

Accepted Forms of Payment

MasterCard, Visa and American Express for practice round cart & range fees, golf shop purchases and food & beverage.

Food and Beverage, Awards Luncheon on September 29

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Chapel Hill Country Club. Food and beverage will be available for championship contestants in the club's Bar & Grill and Beverage Cart daily. Club accepts MasterCard, Visa and American Express for food and beverage purchases. Personal coolers are not allowed.

CGA will host an awards luncheon for all players immediately following play on September 29.

Cell Phones

Except for emergencies, a ruling, viewing tournament leaderboard or use as a distance measuring device, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot. Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice or texting communications and play is not delayed.

Tipping

The CGA encourages players to tip club personnel particularly the outside staff when a service is performed (i.e. placing clubs on carts, cleaning clubs, etc.).

Personal Items

Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the CGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Distance Measuring Devices

Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect (i.e. measure distance only). Note that if a smartphone or tablet is used as a distance measuring device, the distance measuring application must measure distance only and the device must not have any other applications that would render the device non-conforming (i.e. GPS altimeter or anemometer). Compass and weather applications are now permitted on the device.

Championship Format and Schedule

Championship is conducted at 36 holes of stroke play. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the overall championship. Prizes will be awarded to the top-30 overall finishers. Gift certificates expire on December 31, 2015.

September 27 Course available for practice rounds (must call in advance for starting time).
Monday, September 28 First Round: 10:00am shotgun start. Repair field according to score for final round.
Tuesday, September 29 Final Round: 10:00am shotgun start. Hosted lunch and awards immediately following play.

Tournament Policies

Chapel Hill Country Club is a spikeless facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification. Any player who is discovered taking more than 40 seconds to play a stroke is subject to a warning. A second violation will result in a one stroke penalty; third violation will result in a two stroke penalty followed by disqualification.

CGA will post your adjusted gross scores from this championship to your home club handicap.

Text Notifications
