All championship site cart and range fees are included in the entry fee and paid by the CGA. Players have the option to walk or use a golf cart. **Due to the distances between holes, we recommend all players use a golf cart.**

Locker Room: The men's locker room will be available to players during the championship. *Note the locker room is very small with a limited number of lockers and facilities.

Dress Code: Shirts must have a collar (mock neck is OK if 1 ½ inches in height), no denim, no cargo pants, cargo shorts or cut-off shorts, soft-spike shoes.

Coolers: Personal coolers and outside beverages are not allowed.

Accepted Forms of Payment:

Golf Shop: Cash, MasterCard, Visa, American Express;

Food & Beverage: Snack Bar=Cash only; Clubhouse Pub=MasterCard, Visa, American Express

Cell Phone Policy: Silent communications (email, text) only inside clubhouse. Phone calls must be made outside the clubhouse.

Championship Format and Schedule

Championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low 60 scores and ties for the final round. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the championship. Top 30 scores will receive merchandise and are exempt into the 2016 Carolin's Senior Amateur Championship. Merchandise certificates are valid until July 31, 2016.

Saturday, September 12 Tee times available for practice rounds. Must call golf shop in advance.

Sunday, September 13 Round 1. Tee times at 8:00am/12:45pm off #1 and #10 tees.

Monday, September 14 Round 2. Tee times at 8:00am/12:45pm off #1 and #10 tees.

Cut to low 60 scores and ties. Field re-paired according to score.

Tuesday, September 15 Round 3. Tee times begin at 8:00am off #1 and #10 tees.

Awards ceremony immediately following play at scoreboard.

Starting Times

Starting times for September 13-14 will be available on Friday, September 4 by 5:00pm. Check the CGA website at www.carolin'sgolf.org, call the CGA office or the Dataw Island Club golf shop.

Practice Rounds

You are entitled to one practice round on Saturday, September 12 when tee times are available. You may call the golf shop beginning September 5 to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a Carolin's Senior Amateur Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a mandatory \$30.00 cart/range fee for the practice round.

Pull-Carts

Personal pull carts are allowed.

Caddies and Spectators

Caddies are permitted but during the play of a hole, either the player or the caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are welcome at CGA championships however they are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time or rent a spectator cart except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed. Due to the limited number of available carts, spectator carts may not be available for any reason on September 13-14. Check with the CGA staff about cart availability.

Food and Beverage

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Dataw Island Club. Food and beverage will be available for purchase at the Snack Bar located between 9 green/#10 tee and Clubhouse Pub. Personal coolers are not allowed.

Hosted Food Functions

The CGA is working on hosting a food function during the championship. Additional information will be sent once confirmed.

Tournament Policies

Dataw Island Club is a spikeless facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification. One-ball rule is not in effect. The "Notice to Players" rules sheet is available on the Carolinas Senior Amateur Championship home page.

Distance Measuring Devices: Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect (i.e. measure distance only). Note that if a smartphone or tablet is used as a distance measuring device, the distance measuring application must measure distance only and the device must not have any other applications that would render the device non-conforming (i.e. GPS altimeter or anemometer). Compass and weather applications are now permitted on the device.

Cell Phones: Except for emergencies, a ruling, viewing tournament leaderboard or use as a distance measuring device, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot. Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice or texting communications and play is not delayed.

Personal Items: Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the CGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Text Notifications: The Carolinas Golf Association has a new text (SMS) notification feature in the TPP tournament software that will be used to send text messages to your mobile phone in the event of tournament schedule changes, delays and cancellations. This is a free service provided by the CGA. Note that standard texting and data rates apply based upon your cell phone plan.
