Dress Code: Shorts must be Bermuda-length, shirts must have a collar and be tucked in at all times. No denim of any kind is allowed.

**Personal Items:** Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the CGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

**Cell Phones:** Except for emergencies, a ruling, viewing tournament leaderboard or use as a distance measuring device, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot. Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice or texting communications and play is not delayed.

## Starting Times

## Practice Round, Carts and Range Fees, Pull-Carts

You are entitled to one practice round on October 13 after 11:00am when tee times are available. You may call the golf shop starting October 1 to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a Carolinas Super Senior Four-Ball Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a **mandatory** \$25.00 cart/range fee for the practice round.

All championship cart & range fees are included in the entry fee and will be paid by the CGA to the host club.

Contestants must use a cart during championship rounds.

Hendersonville CC accepts cash, check, Discover, American Express, MasterCard or Visa for practice round fees and golf shop purchases.

## Food and Beverage, Awards Luncheon on October 15

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Hendersonville Country Club. Food and beverage will be available for championship contestants in the club's Pro Shop Grill. Club accepts **Cash, Check, Discover, American Express, MasterCard and Visa** for food and beverage purchases. Personal coolers are not allowed.

CGA will host an awards luncheon for all players immediately following play on Wednesday, October 16.

## Tipping

The CGA encourages players to tip club personnel particularly the outside staff when a service is performed (i.e. placing clubs on carts, cleaning clubs, etc.).

**Hotel room rate is valid until September 15. Rooms are subject to hotel availability and standard rates afterwards.**

Lodging is also available at the Mountain Lodge in Flat Rock (828-693-9910). The hotel is located approximately 15 minutes from the golf course. Hotel offers free high-speed Internet access and free continental breakfast each morning. **Championship Format and Schedule**

Championship is conducted at 36 holes of four-ball stroke play. Top 15 overall teams receive merchandise at the conclusion of the championship. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the championship.

Tuesday, October 13 Practice rounds. Must call golf shop in advance for tee time.

Wednesday, October 14 First Round: 9:00am shotgun start. Repair field according to score for final round.

Thursday, October 15 Final Round: 9:00am shotgun start. Hosted lunch and awards immediately following play.
